

International Collaboration in Persons: A New Honoured Doctor of Donetsk National Technical University

On April 28th the Head of the Department of Metal Cutting Machines and Tools of Bryansk State Technical University (BSTU) Prof. A. Khandozhko was awarded the degree of Honoured Doctor of DonNTU. The ceremony was held at the meeting of the Academic Board. Dr. Khandozhko got his degree for many-year collaboration between DonNTU and BSTU, and assistance in training students, postgraduates and doctoral students. The solemn oath was read by one of the eldest professors of DonNTU V. Prisedski, and the Rector of DonNTU Prof. K. Marenich presented the honorary diploma.

Prof. A. Khandozhko thanked the Academic Board of DonNTU and those present in his speech in reply. He spoke about the glorious stages of collaboration of DonNTU and BSTU and mentioned that the degree he had just got was one of the most valuable and honorary awards.

DonNTU continues its collaboration with BSTU and now it gained a new impulse. DonNTU signed its international collaboration agreement with BSTU in 1997 and re-concluded it in 2014.

Prof. A. Mikhailov from DonNTU and Prof. Khandozhko are responsible for the agreement from both parties. Prof. A. Khandozhko is well-known not only in Russia but also far abroad. He published monographs and textbooks and more than 200 scientific papers. He has been awarded a number of international orders, medals and

honorary decorations. Prof. Khandozko joined the International Union of Mechanical Engineers in 2005.

The main stages of collaboration between DonNTU and BSTU are as follows:

1. The Candidate's and Doctoral Dissertation Defense International Board was established in 2015. Scientists from DonNTU, BSTU, and LSU named after V.Dal, and SevSU took part in the work of the Board.
2. Both universities have made some joint international research since 1997.
3. Both universities have held 23 joint scientific and technical conferences "Mechanical Engineering and the Technosphere of the XXI Century" in Sevastopol.
4. Both universities have held 8 joint international scientific and methodological conferences "Modern Problems of the Technosphere and Engineer Training" in Tunisia.
5. Both universities have held 16 joint international scientific and technical students' conferences "Automation, Quality and Mechanical Engineering Technologies" in Donetsk.
6. A number of international conferences in Bryansk have been organized.
7. The delegations from both universities visited laboratories, departments and faculties at both institutions.
8. There is a constant exchange of scientific and technical information, books, curricula and programs between the universities.
9. The researchers of both universities exchange textbooks, methodological literature and information on development of mechanical engineering technologies of both countries.
10. In 2000 both universities took part in the establishment of the international public organization the "International Union of Mechanical Engineers".
11. BSTU was active in rendering humanitarian assistance to the staff of DonNTU under the current difficult geopolitical situation.

III International Scientific and Practical Conference "Modern State and Municipal Management: Problems, Technologies, and Prospects"

On April 2017 the Department of Economic Theory and State Management of Engineering and Economic Faculty and the State Management Magistracy held the III International Scientific and Practical Conference "Modern State and Municipal Management: Problems, Technologies and Prospects".

The Rector of DonNTU Prof. K. Marenich, the First Deputy-



Minister of Education and Science Mr. M. Kushakov, the Dean of the Engineering and Economic Faculty Ms. V. Zhilchenkova greeted the participants at the plenary meeting. They expressed their hopes for the Conference to give a new impulse to the interaction of the theory and practice of the state and municipal management.

The subject-matter of the conference was rather wide. The participants discussed the theoretical and methodological foundations of the state management and organizational issues of its implementation, the informational support of the management and innovation changes taking place at the state management under the processes taking place all over the world.

Richerry, the General Secretary of the European Institute of Political, Economic and Social Research (EURISPES); Prof. A. Nikipelov, the Director of Moscow School of Economics; Prof. A. The producers of electric equipment and relaying devices participating in the exhibition are ready to give the samples of their products to the Electrical Engineering Faculty of DonNTU and train students to adjust and maintain the devices. Our academics also got documentation on the equipment produced by key companies. It will be used in yearly and diploma projects of our students.

We plan to establish close contacts with the equipment producers and organize practice course for students of DonNTU at the companies.



Collaboration with the Company "Sontex Technology"

Prof. A.N. Korchevski has taken part at the technical panel and the round work table organized by "Sontex Technology" (Almaty, Kazakhstan), the joint with Turkey Company.

The prospects of collaboration in industrial waste complex treatment and utilization and building raw material production were discussed.

The company "Sontex Technology" produces build concrete of different modifications and grades and non-steam-cured foam concrete. It also has a plant that produces pressed burnt ceramic and airbrick.



Prof. Korchevski got the information on the current state of the complex treatment of secondary waste in nonferrous metallurgy in Kazakhstan. He also discussed the issues of application of by-product inert materials of treatment of copper slag under the construction material production in the Karaganda and the Almaty Regions, visited some companies of the mining and treatment complex and coordinated collaboration agreements with some interested subjects.

Collaboration with the Company “Advanced Technology Systems”

Dr. S. Khrapko visited the company “Advanced Technology Systems” (Lyubertsi, the RF) in January-March 2017.

He developed algorithms to calculate energy mode of steel-smelting arc furnace with taking into account characteristics of furnace transformers.

The work results were given to the customer.

Further collaboration between DonNTU and the company is the result of the visit.

Collaboration with Taganrog Polytechnic Institute

Prof. Mikhailov and Dr. Lukichov from the Faculty of Engineering Mechanics got the invitation to visit Taganrog Polytechnic Institute which is a branch of Donskoy State University.

They took part at the All-Russian scientific and practical conference “Aspects of Science and Education Development and Industry Modernization” and made their presentations at the plenary meeting. The academics also got acquainted with the system of training specialists and the methodology of Master’s projects doing. They also visited the Institute’s laboratories.

The visit was a success and strengthened further collaboration between DonNTU and Taganrog Polytechnic Institute.

The student of DonNTU A. Komar had his integrated studying at the University of Otto-von Guericke (Magdeburg, Germany).

Experienced specialists explained him the industrial object purpose.
