



Meeting with SEC “Kuzbas-Donbas” Delegation at DonNTU

The Governor of Kemerovskaya oblast – Kuzbas Mr. S. Tsivilyov and the Head of the Donetsk People’s Republic Mr. D. Pushilin signed a cooperation agreement in trade, economic, cultural and other spheres between Kuzbas and the DPR on March 22nd. The meeting of the SEC “Kuzbas” with new participants from the DPR included in the inter-regional SEC “Kuzbas-Donbas” took place at the Ministry of Education and Science of the DPR on April 10th.

A working meeting of the university’s administration and its key professionals in mining and mechanical engineering with the SEC “Kuzbas-Donbas” representatives also took place at DonNTU on April 10th. DonNTU’s Rector Prof. Anoprienko, the First Vice-Rector Dr. A. Karakozov, and the Vice-Rectors Prof. S. Borskhevski, Dr. A. Fyodorov, Dr. A. Ryazanov, the Dean of the Mining Faculty Dr. A. Korchevski, the SMO participant the Dean of the Faculty of Integrated and Mechatronic Manufacturing Dr. A. Bedarev, the Heads of the Departments Prof. V. Gutarevich (Transport Systems and Logistics named after Prof. I. Shtokman), Prof. K. Marenich (Mining Electromechanics and Automation named after Prof. R. Leibov), Prof. A. Mikhailov (Mechanical Engineering), Prof. O. Shabaev (Mining Machines), the SMO participant Prof. V. Poltavets (Mechatronic Systems of Manufacturing Equipment), Dr. A. Kononenko (Energy and Mechanical Systems) and his deputy Dr. V. Gulin represented DonNTU. The Centre Director Ms I. Ganieva headed the delegation of the SEC “Kuzbas-Donbas” which included DonNTU’s partners – representatives of Kuzbas State Technical University.

The participants took a group picture at the university unique symbol – a shaft-sinking set KSP-32 made under the supervision of the Director of Yasinovatski Machine-Building Plant Mr. Trubchanin in 1998 and placed on the territory of the 1st University building. Then the guests visited the laboratories of the Department of Mining Machines and the Department of Mining Electromechanics and Automation where they saw all types of special equipment including acting sets and microprocessor devices.

The meeting continued at the assembly hall of the 1st building. The Rector told the guests about the history of DonNTU, which is one of the first educational institutions of the USSR awarded with the Labour Red Banner Order. He also spoke about the Donbas technical

development. Artyom (F. Sergeev), the founder and the leader of the Donetsk-Krivorozhskaya Soviet Republic (1918) who worked at renovation of mines of the basin, and a student of Donetsk Mining College Nikita Khrushchev, the First Secretary of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union (1953-1964) and the USSR Government Head (1958-1064) played a great role in the process.

The Deans and Departments Heads spoke about new directions of their work, problems and tasks and development prospects.

Ms. I Ganeeva noted the true renovation of the mining industry taking place in the Donbas and recommended to unite the needs of the Centre with DonNTU's abilities and develop a large-scale cooperation program in the frameworks of the SEC "Kuzbas-Donbas".

Online Meeting with Representatives of Higher Education Institute Named after Simon Bolivar (Peru) at DonNTU

There was an online meeting of representatives of DonNTU and the Institute of Higher Education named after Simon Bolivar, the city of Kallao (Peru) at DonNTU on April 17th. The meeting was timed to the 10th anniversary of cooperation between the two educational

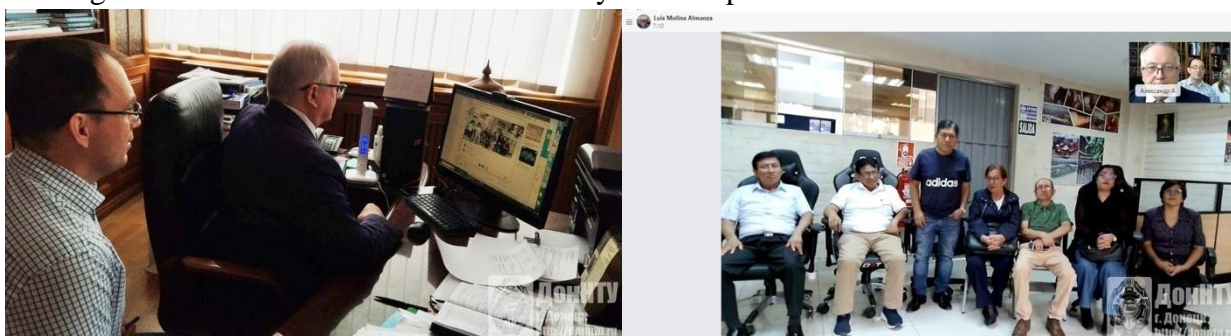

institutions.

DonNTU found some points of contact with Spanish speaking countries in 2007 when a lecturer Ricardo Aliod, the professor of the Mechanical Engineering Faculty form Saragosa University (Spain), the Director of the Research Group and the Consulting Centre GESTAR organized a seminar "Usage of the Program to Create Complex Networks of Water Supply System".

In 2008 DonNTU's representatives took part in the meeting of university-partners working in the frameworks of the European Union grant TEMPUS aimed at increasing the role of the university being the regional innovation centre and improving of interrelations of universities and industry.

The IV International Conference "University Education: New Problems and the Role in Society's Development" took place in Barcelona, Spain in 2008. DonNTU's academics were also present there.

In 2009 a cooperation agreement between Donetsk National Technical University and Kadiz University (Spain) was signed.

In March 2014 a cooperation agreement between Donetsk National Technical University and State Institute of Higher Technical Education named after Simon Bolivar, the city of Kallao (Peru), was signed.

This very year our universities took part in the World Congress in Virtual Education, the plenary meeting of which took place in the biggest hall of Lima (Peru).

In 2016 the "Russian-Spanish Centre named after Miguel de Cervantes" was established at DonNTU. The idea of its establishment had been born long ago. It was caused by students from Latin America studying at DonNTU and huge interest paid by our citizens to the treasures of the great Spanish culture, and economic growth in the counties of Latin America in 2010 and multilateral mutual enrichment in the course of cultural exchanges.

In 2017 zero issue of the magazine “Quijotes” came out. People who fight for their ideals speak about their view on development of the Russian-Spanish Cultural Centre of DonNTU, history of inter-relations of DonNTU and countries of Latin America, feedbacks of our graduates who occupy important posts in the world, the Spanish language courses at DonNTU, flamenco distance courses etc. in the magazine.

DonNTU was represented by its Rector Prof. Anoprienko, the Vice-Rector Dr. Ryazanov and the Director International Dr. Kukushkina. The Institute of Higher Education named after Simon Bolivar was represented by its Director General Victor Fiestas Amaja, the Administration Head Ugo Rekena Argedas, the academic consultant Violete Gutierrez Koakira, and the international links academic consultant Luis Molina.

The parties confirmed their intention to continue the cooperation and resign the agreement with DonNTU under the new realities. A scientific component is the main task of the cooperation. It will cover power engineering, mechanical engineering, and economics. The parties paid much attention to the cultural exchange and events which introduce cultures of both Russia and Peru. Studying of the both countries languages is of paramount importance.

DonNTU's administration expressed their gratitude for assistance in purchasing the equipment for the Engineering Centre established at our university. The parties discussed the prospects of cooperation to carry out research with the application of both universities equipment and events on educational work.

DonNTU Delegation's Visit to Chuvashia is Over

DonNTU's delegation headed by its Rector Prof. Anoprienko took part in the All-Russian Scientific and Technical Conference on Relay Protection and Automation in Chuvashia on April 24th. Representatives of companies which make and use electrical equipment gathered in Cheboksary. Our delegation members saw the results of research carried out by the High Engineering School of Chuvash State University named after I. Ulyanov (CSU) and modern products of such key Russian manufacturers as Cheboksary Apparatus Plant, companies “EKRA”, RELEMATICA”, “BRESLER”, “RADIUS AUTOMATION”, “DINAMICA”, “ELARA” and others which provide technological sovereignty of our country under the sanction limitations. Then our delegation visited Cheboksary Electric Apparatus Plant (CEAP) and the company “EKRA”.

Our Master's and Bachelor students had their internship at CEAP. Their competence level was highly assessed and was interested in cooperation with DonNTU. Our delegation was shown the entire chain of electric goods making.

The company "EKRA" is the Russian key maker of microprocessor units and relay protection systems as well as emergency automation.

On April 25th our delegation visited the company "KASKAD GROUP" which solves a wide range of tasks in industrial automation.

The key moment of the trip to Chuvashia was the official meeting of DonNTU and CSU Rectors and academics which took place in the assembly hall of the university. The Director General of CEAP Mr. Varganov also took part in the meeting. CSU Rector Prof. Alexandrov told the audience about the intermediate result of cooperation with DonNTU: "We have much in common. Both universities are key suppliers of engineers to the companies of their regions. This means we have common spheres of interest and common problems which we can solve together helping each other. Our universities have a significant potential of a fruitful interaction. We will train engineers of a new format that is engineers-creators". DonNTU Rector Prof. Anoprienko told the audience about training process and the interaction with CSU and CEAP. Signing of the tripartite agreement between the universities and CEAP in scientific, innovation and educational spheres aimed at training highly qualified personnel for different branches of industry summed up the meeting. The exchange of students, researchers, books and holding of educational and scientific events – courses, conferences, symposia and lecturers- will be organized in the frameworks of the agreement. Prof. Anoprienko commented on the agreement signing: "We hope for the fruitful and mutually beneficial cooperation".

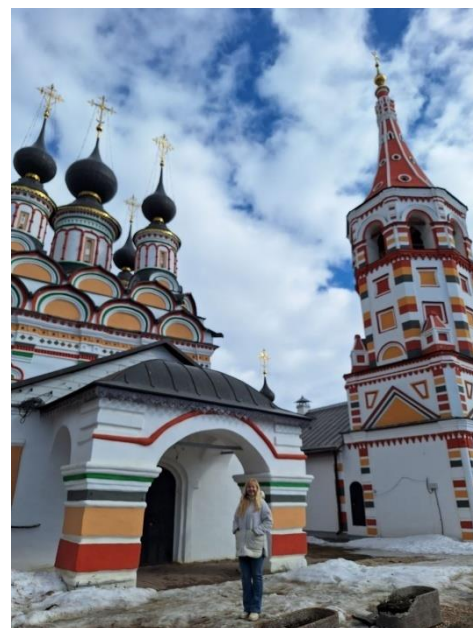

The Dean of the Faculty of Information Systems and Technologies of DonNTU Dr. T. Vasyaeva took part in the Forum of International Technologies 2024 “InfoSpace” on April 01-03d. It was held in Moscow.

Dr. Vasyaeva

1. Took part in the expozone where Russian technologies of import substitution applied in the companies IRIDIUM, Electron Office Systems, ANGARA SECURITY, BASEALT, Eplus, IBMM|TECHNOLOGY, and HYPERCORE were demonstrated. The companies showed the equipment, software, and innovation developments for industry, public sector, transport and financial sphere;
2. Attended a strategic breakup group “Digital Independence in Public Management”. The reports covered such issues as the digital independence priorities in the epoch of “Data Economics”; import substitution; Russian solutions for process automation, defense of digital independence, cybersafety priorities; domestic products to provide information safety in public institutions; cloud technologies in public management; artificial intelligence to control data; prospects of the platform “GosTech” development;
3. Was present at the plenary breakup group “Data Economics: Personnel, Technologies, and Resources”. The reports covered the following issues: “Data Economics”: the future national project priorities; the artificial intelligence in new economic development; creation of the data single authorized warehouse in Russia; a new generation communication system development; building of new 4G and 5G networks; export of national IT solutions; quantum computing developments; strengthening of personnel potential in IT industry; big data in the digital development of Russia; creation of the single digital infrastructure in the economy key branches;
4. Participated in the breakup group “Intellectual Transport Systems”. Such issues as smart transport; new digital transformation trends; the national digital transport and logistics platform; Russian technologies and services in the branch interests; biometrics introduction; unmanned transport development; intellectual transport systems safety were discussed there.

The event was organized in the hybrid format and held in Moscow on April 3-4th. The key topic of the event was “Development of Human Potential in the Interest of Development of Russian Economy”.

More than 1600 people took part in the event. The program included 4 plenary discussions, 14 theme round table meetings and breakup groups. The participants discussed the issues related to industrial, social and bank policies, financial resources, development of rural territories and regions, BRICS, migration and demographic policy, the situation in the Middle East, ESG agenda etc.

More than 100 speakers from 20 countries – Russia, India, the South Africa Republic, China, Brazil, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Germany, Armenia, Egypt, Iran, Belarus, Azerbaijan and others– made their presentations in the frameworks of the Forum. The key industrialists, economists, cultural figures, academicians and representatives of sectoral departments were among the experts.

It should be mentioned that Moscow Economic Forum was formed as an alternative to the global agenda, and its ideas are getting more and more needed in the society. According to Mr. Babkin it is the only world economic forum where participants talk not about profits but about the possibilities for people.

DonNTU's representatives exchanged their experience with Russian and foreign scientists, enriched themselves with new ideas and got to know topical approaches to solve modern economic tasks, and communicated with colleagues from other Russian universities.

DonNTU's Academics Take Part in International Scientific and Practical Conference "Significance and the Role of the Soviet Union in the Victory over the Nazi Germany during the Great Patriotic War of 1941-1945. New Glance and Understanding"

Academics of DonNTU Dr. Penkov and Dr. Polkovnichenko visited Stavropol State Agrarian University (SSAU) on April 9-13th. They made their presentations at the conference and took part in the plenary meeting.

The First Vice-Rector of SSAU Prof. Atanov greeted the participants. He emphasized the current political situation on the territory of Ukraine, the Donetsk and Luhansk people's Republics and importance of the fight with neo-Nazism and history misrepresentation.

Researchers from DonNTU, North-Caucasian Federal University, Dagestan State University and SSAU made their presentations at the plenary meeting. Prof. Musaeva made her presentation "Inestimable Contribution of Dagestan Workers into the Great Victory over the Fascist Germany and its Satellites in 1941-1945". The reports made at the plenary meeting covered the issues of youth activity during the war, deformation of the historic memory about the Great Patriotic War, genocide of the civilian residents of Stalino oblast in 1941-1943, and activity of the ACP(b) during the war.

Dr. Penkov and Dr. Polkovnichenko made two presentations "Contribution of Soviet Power Men into the Victory over the Nazi Germany" and "Donbas Industry during the Years of Occupation in 1941-1943" at the breakup group # 5 "Cities and Towns of South Russia: Occupation and New Orders".

They also negotiated the possibilities of cooperation between DonNTU and SSAU and got to know the characteristics of training at different faculties. They discussed training of highly qualified personnel, advanced courses, and publication of papers in journals of SSAU.

DonNTU Sums Up the Russian Inter-Regional Conference "Regional System of Scientific and Technical Information of the Donetsk People's Republic : the Development Russian Vector"

The Russian Inter-Regional Conference "The Regional System of scientific and Technical Information of Donetsk People's Republic: the Development Russian Vector" was held for the first time ever in Donetsk on February 27-28.

Its organizers were the Institute of Scientific Information in Social Sciences of Russian Academy of Science (Moscow), the Institute of Scientific and Technical Information and DonNTU.

The work of breakup group 2 "Formation of Effective Approaches to Create and Form the Rights of Youth Laboratories in the DPR" was organized in the round table format. The possibilities to speed up science development in the new subjects in the frameworks of youth scientific laboratories formed at

The papers will be published in two conference proceedings – DonNTU's electron archive and data base of the RSI. The participants and their supervisors will get certificates and diplomas.

DonNTU Sums up III Republican Scientific and Practical Conference with International Participation «Topical Issues of Management, Economy and Law»

DonNTU and Donetsk Small Academy of Science held the III Republican Scientific and Practical Conference “Topical Issues of Management, Economy, and Law” on March 19th. 28 universities, 55 colleges, 12 secondary schools, gymnasias and lyceums from the Russian Federation and Belarus took part in it. 95 presentations had been submitted, and 20 of them were heard at 3 breakup groups: “Management”, “Economy”, and “Law”.

The participants were greeted by Dr. Sharnopolskaya from DonNTU who emphasized the significance of the issues of management and its organization in companies under the new economic conditions.

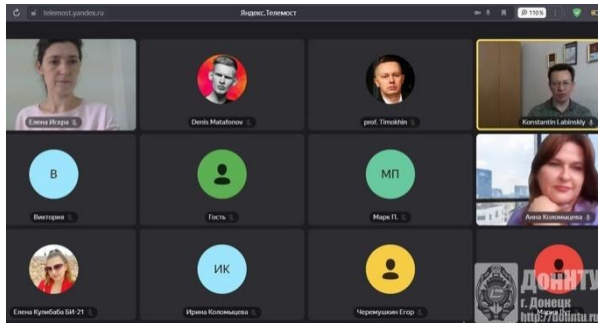

DonNTU Hosts VIII All-Russian Scientific and Practical Conference “Sustainable Development Strategy in Anti-Crisis Control of Economic Systems”

DonNTU hosted the VIII All-Russian Scientific and Practical Conference “Sustainable Development Strategy in Anti-Crisis Control of Economic Systems” timed to the 35th anniversary of the Engineering and Economic Faculty of DonNTU.

The format of the Conference was mixed (online and offline) which allowed representatives of 32 research and academic institutions of the Russian Federation to present results of their research. 50 presentations had been submitted. The participants were greeted by Vice-Rectors, Deans and Directors of the organizations present at the Conference.

The conference covered a wide range of issues on problems and prospects of integration of new regions into the economic space of the Russian Federation, implementation of innovation development of the DPR’s economy under the current conditions. The issues were of great interest to the participants.

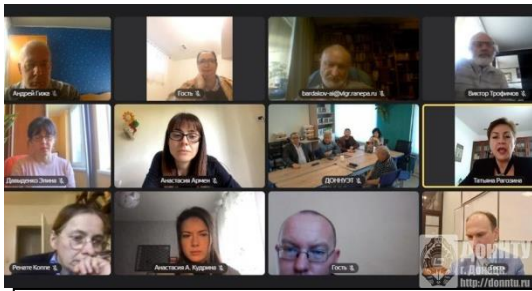

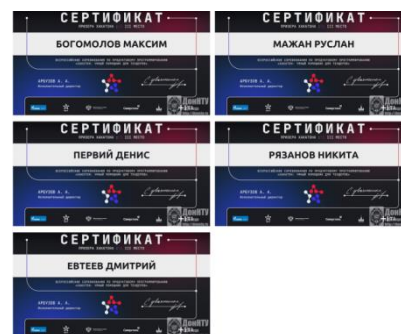

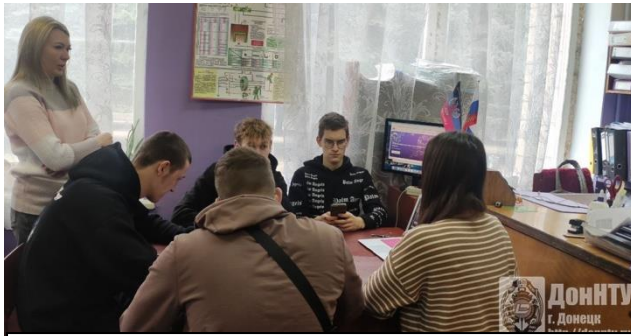
