The guests' visit goal was to form an efficient communication system in the sphere of





DonNTU hosted the **XV** International Scientific and Technical Conference "Informatics, Control Systems, Mathematical and Computer Simulation" (ICSMCS-24) on May 29-30th. It was aimed at scientific information exchange, defining the prospects of the modern society's spheres informatizing, joint scientific programs developing, establishing business and commercial contacts in the sphere of information technologies.



The plenary meeting was organized in the on-line format on May 29th. Consortium of Big Data Researchers and represented DonNTU's IT team «Quintet-in-AI» at the contest of the International University Prize in Big Data and Artificial Intelligence "Gravitation -2024" on May 30th- June 2nd. The events took place in Moscow with the Russian Academy of National Economy and State Service under the President of the Russian Federation being their host.

The Prize "Gravitation- 2024" is one of the biggest annual events in Russia

which popularize the most significant projects of educational institutions in the sphere of artificial intelligence and big data. Its main goal is focused on strengthening efficient cooperation to implement joint projects and initiatives in the sphere of big data analysis and introduction of artificial intelligence into the university infrastructure.

Representatives of the executive power federal boards, researchers and experts in the sphere of artificial intelligence, IT teams of the key universities which introduce artificial intelligence into training and research met there.

Being the leader of DonNTU's IT team «Quintet-in-AI» Dr. Fedyaev presented a project for the International University Prize in Artificial Intelligence and Big Data "Gravitation -2024".

He made his presentation on the project in the nomination "AI-Human Being" on behalf of the team.

Our project was among 18 out of 170 projects in the nomination included into the working program of the Congress where Dr. Fedyaev made his presentation "Simulation of a Complex System of Training Specialists Based on its Intellectualization by the Artificial Intelligence methods".

DonNTU Representative Participates in the All-Russian Seminar-meeting of University Psychologists

The All-Russian seminar-meeting of university psychologists was held at EANE on June 4-6. The organizers are the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation and Tula State University. The event was attended by 250 psychologists and heads of psychological services of universities in 63 regions of Russia. DonNTU was represented by educational psychologist Olga Viktorovna Sokolova. The seminar-meeting provided discussion platforms with



invited experts, within which the audience got acquainted with the construction of a universal system of psychological support. The participants strengthened their professional skills of group work in various formats.

The Books of the DonNTU's Employee are Presented at the XXX Beijing International Book Exhibition-2024 (Beijing, China)

On June 19-23, the 30th Beijing International Book Fair Beijing International Book Fair-2024 was held at the Chinese National Convention Center China National Convention Center. The Dean of the Faculty of Geology, the Head of one of the Faculty's departments of Donetsk National Technical University Dr. Alexander Nikolaevich Korchevsky was invited to take part in the exhibition. The exhibition is organized by the China National Publications Import & Export Group and has been held on an ongoing basis since 1986. Currently, the exhibition is the second largest book forum in the world and the largest book exhibition in the Asian region. Over 1.600 exhibitors from more than 70 countries took part in the Beijing Book Fair in 2024, over 220 thousand books in all major categories were presented at the exhibition grounds: from educational and scientific literature to non-fiction and works of art. The Academy of Natural Sciences, as an official participant, presented its own exposition of scientific, educational, encyclopedic literature, educational materials and technologies:

The opening of the exhibition was attended by Chen Dongjie, the Director of the Beijing Publishing Group, and Liu Jianwei, the Chairman of the Chinese Literary Author's Community, and representatives of the Republic's community. Dr. A.N. Korchevsky presented his books on the following topics at the exhibition:

- 1. Theory and technique of physical experiment in mineral processing;
- 2. Design of processing plants. The workshop;
- 3. Enrichment of ferrous metal ores;
- 4. Ore enrichment. The workshop
- 5. Flotation methods of mineral processing.

More than 1000 seminars and cultural events dedicated to the main problems of book publishing were held within the framework of the exhibition.

Discussions on the problems and prospects of international development of modern book publishing, problems of translation and distribution of foreign literature in China were also held. Business meetings with leading publishing houses of the participating countries, press conferences with participation of well-known public figures and representatives of China were also organized.

DonNTU Teacher is a Finalist of the Competition "The Best Young Teacher in the SOUTH of Russia"

The interregional innovation competition "The Best Young Teacher of the South of Russia 2024" was held in Rostovon-Don on June 13-15th. Olga Valentinovna Rychka, the Associate Professor of the Department of Software Engineering named after L. P. Feldman, took part in its final. 32 young university teachers from the southern regions of our country, as well as from the North-West of Russia, Siberia and the Volga region, the DPR, the LPR and the Zaporozhye region competed for the title of the best at Rostov State University of Economics. At the opening ceremony it was noted that all participants of the face-toface stage were already winners of the competition, as their applications had been selected from more than a hundred submitted to the organizing committee this year. After the ceremonial part the finalists were expected to be tested. They had to talk vividly, interestingly and clearly about their discipline and topic in a mini-lecture in just 15 minutes.

The Forum gathered more than 150 participants from 20 Russian cities, representing 50 universities and industrial partners. Among them was the chairman of the Council of Young Scientists of Donetsk National Technical University, Associate Professor of the Department of Computer Modeling and Design Maria Pavlovna Rudenko. The main topics

were as follows: 1) Advanced engineering schools – the experience of universities and industrial partners in the transformation of engineering education; 2) artificial intelligence – new technologies and tools that have a significant impact on modern education; 3) Technological entrepreneurship – opportunities and challenges for higher education. The Forum was opened by the Rector of Don State Technical University Besarion Chokhoevich Meskhi followed by panel discussions

"SCHOOLS and universities – effects or struggle?", "AI in education – who is who?", "Student Startup – is there a Right to Life?" and many others. The first day ended with the defense of graduation papers in the "Startup as a Diploma" format, where students presented their projects to the investment committee. The second day of the Forum was held in the format of design workshops, where the following topics were discussed: "Startup Versus Diploma", "Maps of Advanced Engineering Schools" and "Science for the Young: Innovations on the Don".

On July 15- 20th the Head of the Department of Design Work of Students of DonNTU Elena Vladimirovna Alekseeva was invited to take part in the XII All-Russian Congress of Councils of Young Scientists and Students' Scientific Societies, which was held in Vladivostok. The All-Russian Congress of Councils of Young Scientists and Students' Scientific Societies is held annually on behalf of the President of Russia and is included in the events of the Decade of Science and Technology. Its main goal is to involve the community of young scientists in solving the most important tasks of the development of the society and our country. On July 15-17, 2024 the XII Congress of Councils of Young Scientists and Students' Scientific Societies was held in Vladivostok at the site of Far Eastern Federal University/ It was organized by the Coordinating Council for Youth Affairs in the Scientific and Educational Spheres of the Presidential Council for Science and Education with the support of the Government of Primorsky

The Participants discussed new strategic documents adopted this year, highlighted support measures and designed the program of the Congress of Young Scientists (Sirius, November 20-22, 2024). E.V. Alekseeva attended a number of events: 1) panel

The conference proceedings are available on the DonNTU website in the electronic archive (external link), as well as on the Conference website(external link) The materials present the results of scientific research and technical developments in the field of modern metallurgical and foundry technologies, metalworking, materials science, metal science and heat treatment of metals. The issues of energy-saving technologies, technical thermophysics, and ecology and labor protection in metallurgy are considered. The articles are of interest to students, postgraduates, scientific and engineering workers of the metallurgical profile.

On May 30-31st St. Petersburg State University of Telecommunications named after Prof. M. A. Bonch-Bruevich hosted the final of Open Cyber Studies of Universities of the Northwestern

Federal District "Cyber Northwest 2024". The final round was preceded by an absentee qualifying, which took place on April 25. It was necessary to scan the network traffic dump for computer attacks. According to the results of the qualifying round, 11 out of 19 participating teams made it to the final, including the team of Donetsk National Technical University. In the final, the participants faced a difficult task — analysis using the methods of forensic of the provided virtual machine

images. According to the legend, the company's information infrastructure has become the subject of hacker aspirations of intruders. The company was attacked by a cryptographic virus. The computer incident consisted of a chain of successive successful computer attacks. The teams needed to identify the types of computer attacks, try to restore access to the company's servers on which the attacks were carried out, from where the data was stolen/encrypted, examining the chain of network topology. The awarding of the winners and the presentation of certificates took

place on May 31. Representatives of DonNTU also received a preliminary invitation to become participants of the All-Russian Scientific Summer School on Information Security.

substation in the Moscow region. Until 2011, the Personnel Training Center (CCI) St. Petersburg Bely Rast was the only training center for additional professional education in PJSC ROSSETI. Currently, the main areas of training at the Personnel Training Center of the ROSSETI branch of St. Petersburg Bely Rast are:

- 1. Operational maintenance of substations;
- 2. Repair and maintenance of overhead lines;
- 3 Repair and diagnostics of substation equipment;
- 4. Maintenance of RZiA devices.
- 5. The practice consisted of two parts "School of a young engineer (SHMI)" and "Student Construction teams (SSO)".

During the SHMI, the trainees completed training courses in the following areas: 1) Labor Protection. Training "Behavioral Security Audit"; 2) Fire Safety Rules at Power Facilities. Fire Fighting Training; 3) The Method of First Aid and Resuscitation of an Electric Shock Victim. Practical part: Practicing

Resuscitation Techniques on the Gosha Dummy Simulator; 4) Elimination of Violations. Working with Staff; 5) Conducting Activities that Increase the Level of Group Cohesion for Students; 6) Power Transmission Lines: Design Features, Maintenance, Repair Technology. Polygon; 7) The Main Equipment of the PS; 8) The RZA Maintenance System. Devices and Systems for Checking REA; 9) Interaction with Customers and the Electricity Market.

The excursions were also included into the visit to the 220 kV Skolkovo underground substation and the 500 kV Pakhra substation. Student construction teams included two groups – "Grozotros" (students of the Moscow Power Engineering Institute) and "First Watt" (students of the Ivanovo State Power Engineering University named after V. I. Lenin, Donetsk National Technical University and Lugansk State University named after V. I. Dahl).

On July 1, the students' teams opened the 65th labor season and the 15th season of work in the students' teams of PJSC ROSSETI. All students completed production tasks for cleaning and caring for the territory of the CCP and the substation. Their total number was 30 people. Over the weekend DonNTU students got acquainted with Moscow, visited Red Square, the Cosmonautics Museum at EANE and the historic Kitay-Gorod district. The production practice at the branch of PJSC ROSSETI – MES Center at the 750kV Bely Rast substation made good impressions on the Donetsk polytechnics.
