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Heads of DonNTU - Participants of Seminar-Meeting of Ministry of Science of Russian Federation with Educational and Scientific Organizations of New Territories

On November 14-16th the third seminar-meeting with heads of educational and scientific organizations of the Donetsk People's Republic, Luhansk People's Republic, Kherson and Zaporozhzhye regions was held in Rostov-on-Don. This event was held in connection with functioning and improvement of the interaction between the educational and scientific structures of the territories. One of the key figures who took part in the seminar was the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation - Viktor Nikolayevich Falkov. His presence emphasized the importance and relevance of this event, as well as Russia's readiness to maintain cooperation with partners from the Donetsk People's Republic, the Luhansk People's Republic, the Kherson and Zaporozhye regions. Among the participants of the seminar it is necessary to mention the Rector of Donetsk National Technical University, Alexander Yakovlevich Anoprienko, as well as the Vice-Rectors of the university. Their representation at the event showed the willingness and desire of Donetsk National Technical University to actively cooperate with other scientific and educational institutions and to develop the exchange of experience and knowledge.

The event was aimed at achieving the goal of summarizing the intermediate results of integration into the single scientific and educational space. Within the framework of this event, issues related to the further development of scientific and educational organizations of higher education located in the territory of the new subjects of the Russian Federation were discussed.

V.N. Falkov paid special attention to the results of the enrollment campaign 2023 and modernization of the university infrastructure. On the instructions of the President, in 14 universities of the new regions of Russia 43 study laboratories will be created by the end of the year. It is important to note that all the capabilities of these laboratories should be fully utilized in the educational process. In addition, five university-based engineering centres will be established. Administrations had already bought the necessary equipment and the centres will be

open before the end of the year. They will specialize in such areas as instrumentation, energy efficiency technologies, new materials, tool making industry, physical and chemical technologies, rational subsoil use and transport engineering. The staff and managers of these centres will also undergo a special training programme conducted by the country's best universities and major technology companies.

During the meeting, the participants actively discussed various working issues, shared valuable experience and accumulated knowledge in the field of education, science and educational work.

However, certainly, the significant moment during the meeting was a solemn ceremony of transfer of buses, each of which is designed for 35 passengers. This transfer was carried out within the framework of the programme of socio-economic development of new regions and was addressed to the rectors of 11 universities under the jurisdiction of the Russian Ministry of Education and Science.

On November 23-24th the VIII International Scientific and Practical Conference "Business Engineering of Complex Systems: Models, Technologies, Innovations - BECS-2023" was held at the Department of Economic Cybernetics of Donetsk National Technical University. The event

was timed to discuss topical issues and prospects for the development of business engineering of complex systems.

The conference partners were Ural Federal University named after the first President of Russia B. N. Yeltsin, Donetsk State University, Polotsk State University and the European Society of Structural Integrity.

The conference brought together leading experts in the field of big data analysis and artificial

intelligence engineering from the school of professional and academic education of the Institute of Radio-Electronic and Information Technologies - RTF of the Ural Federal University named after B.N. Yeltsin in Russia.

The plenary session was greeted by the Rector of DonNTU Alexander Yakovlevich Anoprienko, the Director of the Institute of Radio-Electronic and Information Technologies - RTF of Ural Federal University named after B. N. Yeltsin Ilya Nikolayevich Obabkov, Tatyana Vasyaeva, the

The conference covered the issues of interaction between the higher education system and the labor market; the prospects of development, management, modeling and design of enterprises; the challenges of introducing artificial intelligence and machine learning into the digital economy; data analysis and modelling technologies; big data processing methodology; simulation tools in decision-making systems.

The DonNTU's History Museum Hosts Event **Dedicated to Students' International Day**

On November 13th the Museum of History of Donetsk National Technical University held an exciting event - a retrospective exhibition dedicated to the international relations of the university and the training of foreign students. This exhibition marked an important stage in the development of the university, which for many years was a respected center of education among

foreign students. The exhibition presents various artifacts related to the life and cooperation of foreign students and polytechnics. Here you can find photos reflecting lessons in classrooms and working practice, as well as moments of leisure and various events related to the exchange of national traditions in the Interclub. In addition, the exhibition presents issues of the newspaper "Donetsk Polytechnic" with publications on international relations, as well as textbooks in Chinese. The exposition was visited by students, teachers and employees of the university who want to get acquainted with this interesting and informative collection.

The exhibition in the Museum of the University's History was opened by the Director Lidia Dmitrievna Kovaleva. She introduced the first foreign students who were citizens of the People's Republic of China. The systematic training of these students began in 1954 at the Mining and Geological Faculty. Over time, since the 1960s, students from 65 countries of Asia, Africa and Latin America have started to study at DPI. In 1954 - 1996 about 5, 000 foreign nationals

obtained engineering degrees.

The Vice-Rector Andrey Ryazanov expressed his sincere gratitude to the Director of the History Museum Lidia Dmitrievna Kovaleva for her outstanding organizational work. During his speech, he shared memories of his own studies and contacts with foreign students, and expressed special gratitude for their tireless work and perseverance in the pursuit of knowledge. Andrey Nikolayevich noted that the exposition of the museum caused a huge interest due to its ability to convey a complete picture of the history and scope of international cooperation of those times.

Gennady Klyagin, the Dean of the French Engineering Faculty and Oleg Kuzmich Moroz ,who was responsible for the Czech direction , shared their rich experience of work with foreign

students at Donetsk Polytechnic Institute and abroad. According to domestic plans and methods, significantly different from foreign ones, they trained students of polytechnics abroad. Local students, who studied under foreign programs, expressed a desire to adopt the same methods of teaching. Consequently, the curricula developed by the scientists of Donetsk National Technical University glorified its name. Oleg Kuzmich Moroz also spoke about the activities of the Dean's Office

of Foreign Students, the creation of compatriots and the work of the Interclub. Meetings with representatives of the compatriots took place regularly. The Rector of the University of that time, George Vasilyevich Maleev, necessarily held meetings once a month. During these meetings the Rector acquainted himself with the problems faced by foreign students and took all necessary steps to solve them. For Donetsk and foreign graduates DonNTU university years are remembered as the most unforgettable and pleasant period of their life. Remembering this time, they happily talk about days spent together, study and their free time.

In the period from 2 to 7 November the employees of DonNTU E.R. Solovyeva and senior lecturer of the department «Accounting and Audit», the Head of the Department for the Organization of Educational Work with Students I.M. Yurkova were invited to take part in the training program of the staff representatives teaching social and humanitarian subjects. The program was held at the Knowledge Center «Mashuk» in Pyatigorsk.



On November 7-11th the delegation of Donetsk National Technical University led by Deputy Dean Oleg Vyacheslavovich Penkov, Sergey Nikolayevich Tkachenko, Associate Professor, the Head of the Department «Electric Stations», and Dr. Dmitry Viktorovich Polkovnichenko visited Stavropol Agrarian State University (Stavropol, Russia). 3 presentations were made in the breakup group «Soviet History and Historical Memory in Modern Russian Society», devoted to the historical stages of development of the energy industry in Donbas within the framework of the program of events.

The purpose of the visit is to make presentations at the Conference, to search for opportunities for cooperation between DonNTU and SASU, as well as to get acquainted with the organization of the educational process at the related Electric Power Faculty.

Within the framework of the Conference members of the delegation of DonNTU took part in the plenary session. Scientists from Donetsk State University, North Caucasus Federal University and Stavropol State Agrarian University addressed the plenary session. Representatives of the Department of Business and Personnel Management of Donetsk National Technical University took part in the 38th International Scientific and Practical Conference «Innovation Management-2023», also known as the Drucker Readings. The Conference was held on November 13-15 at the Institute of Management Problems named after V.A. Trapeznikov of the Russian Academy of Sciences in Moscow. This event has become traditional for the department, and its participation allows the university representatives to be aware of the latest trends in management and innovation. The Head of the Department of Business and Personnel Management, Associate Professor Inna Alexandrovna Kondaurova, and the academic of the same department Alina Vladimirovna Yemelyanenko represented DonNTU with a study on the topic "Features of Intellectual Property Management of Scientific Organizations in the Conditions of New Regions of Russia". The Conference was led by the Professor Robert Mikhailovich Nizhegorodtsev, the Head of the Laboratory of Economic Dynamics and Innovation Management of the Institute of Management Problems named after V.A. Trapeznikov. Drucker Readings is an annual international scientific and practical event which main purpose is to stimulate and promote ideas and practices in the field of leadership, management and innovation. The event is named after the renowned philosopher and manager Peter Drucker, who is considered one of the most influential thinkers in the field of governance in the 20th century. Drucker's readings became a significant event for entrepreneurs, managers

and scientists. The Conference brought together professionals and experts who sought to discuss and share their knowledge, experience and ideas in the field of innovative management. The event participants shared their experiences, presented their research and discussed topical issues related to research innovation management.

Innovation strategy is becoming an increasingly important topic in today's world. Well-known experts shared their experience of successful implementation of new ideas and technologies, as well as creation of a favourable innovation culture in organizations. They cited real-world



examples of research and innovative projects that have succeeded and helped companies maintain their competitive advantage.

Within the framework of the conference such issues as risk management in innovation projects, commercialization of scientific developments, development strategies of startups and the role of leadership in the innovation process were discussed. Participants were able to discuss the current challenges and trends faced by managers and entrepreneurs in implementing their

innovative ideas. They also expanded their knowledge, gained information about the latest trends and best practices in innovation management, and established business relationships with colleagues and experts from different industries.

Teacher of DonNTU - Participant of VIII International Forum «Russia and the World: New Walls or New Rules»

In the period from 20.11.2023 to 24.11.2023 Professor of the Department «Economic Theory and Public Administration» of DonNTU Y.V.Khomenko was invited to take part in the VIII International Forum «Russia and the World: New Walls or New Rules» held at the Financial University under the Government of the Russian Federation (Moscow).

The Forum was held with the participation of members of the Government of the Russian Federation, management of the Bank of Russia, heads of subjects of the Russian Federation, representatives of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation, business, expert community and science.

During the mission, Y.V. Khomenko performed the following work:

1) Attended the plenary session of the fFrum, which was devoted to the discussion of new fair and equitable rules of the game, the construction of a new financial system, the role of

Russia in the global financial architecture. The leading speakers of the forum were Finance Minister of the Russian Federation A.G. Siluanov, President of RSPP A.N. Shokhin, Deputy Chairman of the Federation Council of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation N.A. Zhuravlev. Among the topical issues of the agenda the influence of world trends on the development and transformation of the socio-economic space of Russia: its regions, agglomerations, the problems of reforming Russia's national innovation system in the face of sanctions, the peculiarities and problems of monitoring the implementation of priority national

projects, the new world order and technology of gaining moral leadership, Russia's geopolitical

strategy in the context of confrontation with the West, strategic management of the scientific and technological sphere in the context of external and internal challenges were discussed.

- 2) Took part as an expert in one of the events of the Forum the International Scientific and Practical Conference «Spatial Development of Russia: the Current State and Long-term Planning Horizons». In the course of the presentations and the discussion, the experts discussed new challenges facing the subjects of the Russian Federation, opportunities and limitations of the implementation of State strategies of fiscal and monetary policy in the Russian Federation in the context of new economic realities, strategic planning of scientific and technological progress, science and innovation, multi-dimensional hierarchical territorial sovereignty of Russia, etc.
- 3) It was possible to communicate and exchange contacts with the Director of the Institute of Regional Economy and Inter-Budget Relations of the Financial University under the Government of the Russian Federation, the Associate Professor Pavel Viktorovich Stroev. They discussed the possibility of participation in the projects of the Institute carried out by order of the Government of the Russian Federation, the authorities of individual regions and districts.

One of the results of the mission is an invitation to publish the results of scientific research as an article in the publications of the Financial University.

In the period from 20 to 25 November 2023 Assistant professor of the Department of International Economy A.Y.Shcherbina visited the Autonomous Non-profit Organization of Higher Education «University of World Civilizations named after V.V. Zhirinovsky» in Moscow and took part in the VI International Scientific and Practical Conference "Great Eurasia: National and Civilization Aspects of Development and Cooperation". The Conference was organized by the University of World Civilizations, Eurasian Information and Analytical Consortium, Scientific Council of the Russian Academy of Sciences on complex problems of Eurasian

These two unique sites are valuable sources of information about patents, inventions and brands necessary for the advancement of our national and global industry.

Exchange of experience and knowledge with experts in the field of intellectual property plays a significant role in the development of research work at DonNTU. This broadens the horizons and enriches the methodology of our research in this field. In addition, such exchanges strengthen scientific ties and cooperation with domestic institutions and organizations.

Director of DonNTU STL - Participant of VI Educational Intensive IPR EDU 2023

On October 25-28th the Russian International Olympic University in Sochi held the VI Educational Intensification IPR EDU 2023. The event gathered participants from all over the country, and the Donetsk People's Republic was represented to by Director of the Scientific and Technical Library of Donetsk National Technical University Irina Yuryevna Kolyupanova. The opening of the intensive course event was a plenary session entitled «From Accreditation Monitoring of Educational Programs to Strategic Changes in Education» organized under the guidance of highly qualified specialists - adviser to the Head of Rosobrznadzor and the Head of the Rosobrznadzor Situational Center for accreditation monitoring, the Director for the development of the group of companies «Education» Natalia Vasilyevna Altynikova. She stressed the importance of accreditation monitoring in identifying difficult areas of concern in

the education system. This is an initial step towards strategic changes that may affect future education. As part of further activities, the meeting participants will be able to conduct a more detailed review of the accreditation monitoring data and develop strategic solutions to improve the quality of education. An important advantage of this intensification is the association of leading experts involved in the development of education in order to effectively deal with

the current problems of the education system and to create a solid basis for the future. Sergey Rukavishnikov, the Deputy Head of Rosobradzor, is at the forefront of the state accreditation of educational activity, and in his speech he highlighted a number of innovations in the regulation of this sphere. He specified that the time had come not for officials to dictate and create different indicators and requirements, but for members of the academic community with extensive experience and expertise.

State accreditation is an important process that determines the quality and conformity of educational institutions. Alexey Yemelyanov, the Head of the RosaccredAgency, introduced the relevant normative documentation, which plays a crucial role in this process. According to Mr. Emelyanov, State accreditation is now more smooth and simplified than in previous years. However, much still depends on diagnostic indicators.


