The event was held on the platforms of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Federal Research Center "Computer Sciences and Control" of RAS, Global Processes Faculty of Moscow State University named after M.V. Lomonosov, as well as of partner universities, among them Baltic State Technical University "VOENMEKH" named after D.F. Ustinov, Russian State University for the Humanities, Peoples' Friendship University of Russia named after Patrice Lumumba, Russian Economic University named after G.V. Plekhanov (Moscow), Financial University under the Government of the Russian Federation, Federal Institute for Educational Development of RANEPa, Belorussian State University, Kyrgyz-Russian Slavic University named after B.N. Yeltsin, International Sakharov Environmental

Institute of Belorussian State University, Belgrade University (Serbia), University of Nis (Serbia) and many others. DonNTU has been engaged in holding Moiseev Readings for the first time.

Welcoming speeches were delivered by remote attendees of the conference, the DonNTU's Rector Prof. A. Anoprienko and Prof. V. Petrishchev, the Rector of International Independent University of Environmental and Political Sciences. Prof. A. Anoprienko gave also a report devoted to the analysis of global processes of technosphere evolution in light of N. Moiseev ideas

and prediction of our civilization development.

Head of the Department of Physics Dr. A. Volkov in his report considered the problems of school education and their impact on the training quality of university graduates, analyzed the difference between modern school program and those of the Soviet period, emphasized the main shortcomings of modern school textbooks.

The Associate Professor of the Department of Economics and Marketing of DonNTU Dr. E. Polyakova made a report on the research devoted to updating of a set of tools and organizing methods for building the students' capacity to internal development through facilitation of engineering education.

The Associate Professor of the Department of Applied Mathematics and Artificial Intelligence of DonNTU Dr. I. Anokhina informed the audience about the experience and possibilities of using online education as a tool for forming professional competences of students and university personnel.

The senior teacher of the DonNTU's Physics Department Ye. Savchenko spoke about peculiarities of adaptation of the first year students to learning Physics in the technical university.

The event was held in a mixed format, in person and online, using the MTS Link platform. The high-quality videoconference was ensured by the representatives of the Organizing Committee and Telecommunication Systems Division of the Centre for Information Computer Technology.

Each of the presentations raised genuine interest as evidenced by the questions of the event participants.

DonNTU Representatives Take Part in All-Russian Session “Model of Higher Engineering Education”

On March 13-14, the Vice-Rector of the Donetsk National Technical University Dr. Andrey Fyodorov and the Head of the Department for Teaching Work Oleg Fyodorov took part in the All-Russian session “Model of Higher Engineering Education” held by the Saint Petersburg Mining University Empress Catherine II.

At the event, representatives of Russia's leading technical universities discussed the progress and results of the pilot project implemented by the Mining University as to reforming higher engineering education, as well as the SPMU's vision of such reforms all over the country. The participants of the session agreed that this very reform, which implies rejection of the Bologna system and is based on the best traditions of the national higher education, is necessary to solve the extremely urgent task of providing Russian enterprises with qualified engineering personnel.

On March 13-15, the XXXI International Scientific and Practical Conference of Students and Postgraduates “Radioelectronics, Electrical Science and Power Engineering” was held by the Moscow Power Engineering Institute (MPEI National Research University). More than 1200 students

and postgraduates took part in the work of 64 breakup groups in thirteen topics. This event gives engineers, designers and industry representatives a chance to live interact with the producers, representatives of power generation companies, and scientists, as well as to discuss a wide range of the topical issues related to power industry and environment.

The conference was attended in person by DonNTU's 20 postgraduates, students and their mentors headed by the Rector Prof. A. Anoprienko, who delivered a report on a topical theme “Donbas energy re-equipment as the basis of region's revival and advanced development”.

Moreover, on March 13, the DonNTU's Faculty of Intelligent Power Engineering and Robotics organized the work of breakup group 64 “Special Issues of Donbas Power Engineering” at the remote and in-person format, headed by Dr. I. Gulyaieva, Associate Professor of Electric Systems Department, Dr. A. Bulgakov, Deputy Dean of the Faculty of Intelligent Power Engineering and Robotics, Associate Professor of Electric Systems Department and Dr. A. Larin, Associate Professor of Electric Systems Department. The representatives of

academic teaching staff of DonNTU and MPEI NRU actively participated in the discussion of the reports.

DonNTU’s Academics Participate in Moscow International Education Show MMCO.EXPO-2025



At the invitation of the Russian Academy of Natural Sciences (International Association of Scientists, Teachers and Specialists), the First Vice-Rector Dr. A. Karakozov and Dean of the Mining Faculty Dr. A. Korchevski have visited the XII Moscow International Education Show MMCO.EXPO-2025, the key educational event of Russia, held on March 5-6.

Since 2020 the International Museum Show (MMCO) has been operating in the hybrid format, bringing together the offline space of Expocentre’s pavilion and MMCO-Connect: MMCO.EXPO.ONLINE platform. During the last years, due to the joint efforts of the Ministry of Higher Education and Science of the Russian Federation and the Ministry of Education of the

Russian Federation, the Show has attracted over 15 thousand visitors in its exhibition hall in 2025.

More than 200 participants have presented their latest developments at the exhibition: from modern educational technologies to infrastructure and intelligent solutions. The representatives of various business spheres, as well as teachers, students and schoolchildren of all levels of educational system have visited the exhibition during the two days of its work. Within the framework of the large-scale show, there were numerous sessions devoted to topical issues in the field of education, among which special attention was paid to the synchronization of educational programs with the needs of production for the future economic development of the country. More than 120 sessions and expert discussions were held on the virtual platform of MMCO.EXPO-2025.

The Academy of Natural Sciences has contributed to the Moscow Education Show having organized its own online session. Within the framework of this event, the extended four-hour discussion was organized, which focused on the critical issues facing the educational system today.

At the platform of the exhibition the Academy presented a wide range of materials including academic journals, teaching aids, methodical developments and scientific literature published over the last years. In addition, the catalogues with detailed information on editions available at the Academy's online exhibition were showcased.

Descriptions of the works of Dr. A. Karakozov and Dr. A. Korchevski were included into the list of publications submitted to the Moscow International Education Show MMCO.EXPO-2025. This decision was made in accordance with the policy of the RANS Presidium, aimed at support and information promotion of the authors of educational and scientific publications. The demand, scientific novelty and value of these works for the educational process were taken into account.

Head of Youth Research Laboratory “Artificial Intelligence” Take Part in Program for Development of Management Personnel Reserve in Science, Technology and Higher Education

Dr. Olga Rychka, the Head of Youth Research Laboratory “Artificial Intelligence” Associate Professor of DonNTU’s Software Engineering Department named after L.P. Feldman, became a participant in the fourth stream of a program for the development of the management personnel reserve in the field of science, technology and higher education. Its first module was held on the federal territory of Sirius University on March 12-15. The program is implemented on behalf of the President of the Russian Federation Vladimir Putin with the support of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation on the basis of the Higher School of Management of the Presidential Academy and Sirius University of Science and Technology, in partnership with leading Russian educational centres.

The participants of the event were 85 people from 28 subjects of the Russian Federation, among them were heads of scientific organizations, labs, technological companies, leading specialists of the universities. They all belong to the personnel reserve of the Russian Ministry of Education and Science.

The program consists of four educational modules. Apart from Sirius University, they will be held on the basis of other Russian universities and educational centres. Within the frame of each module the participants will implement project work. The outcome of the program will be defense of team projects before the expert commission.

The first educational module included seminars, lectures and practical classes. In addition, the participants got to know more about the infrastructure of Sirius federal territory, its mission and work results.

On March 15, the listeners of the fourth stream presented to the Deputy Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation Denis Sekirinskiy the topics of their projects aimed at developing solutions for current issues in the field of scientific and technological development of the country.

On March 04, the VII International Scientific and Practical Conference “Topical Issues of World Economy” was held at the basis of the DonNTU’s Department of International Economics along with the Economic Research Institute (Donetsk), Donetsk Small Academy of Science, **Yaroslav-the-Wise Novgorod State University, Abkhaz State University, South-Ossetian State University named after A. Tibilov and Don State**

Technical University. More than 80 representatives of educational institutions of the Russian Federation, the Transdnistria Moldavian Republic and the Republic of Belarus took part in it.

The conference goal was to give young researches a chance to show results of their work and share opinions in different issues of the world economy.

The participants were greeted by Dr. I. Kochura, the Deputy Dean of the Faculty of Engineering and Economics for Scientific Work, Prof. V. Zubkov, the Director of Donetsk Small Academy of Science, Dr. L. Abdalyan, Deputy Head of the Department of Interdisciplinary Scientific Research, Innovations and Training of Teaching Staff, Head of the Board of Young Scientists and Professionals of the Economic Research Institute, Dr. L. Shabalina, the Head of the Department of International Economics.

The conference was moderated by Dr. G. Shavkun, Associate Professor of the Department of International Economics.

This year the young researches paid special attention to various issues of the development process of innovations and digitalization of the world economy, as well as integration relations of the countries of South-East Asia and the Eurasian Economic Union, prospects of Russian economy development under the international sanctions and others.

The reviewed research papers will be published in two conference proceedings, one is placed in the DonNTU’s electron archive, the another – in the RSI data base. Also, young researches, who delivered their reports, along with their supervisors will be awarded with diplomas; the rest of the participants will get certificates.

DonNTU Holds IV All-Russian Scientific and Practical Conference of Studying Youth “Topical Issues of Management, Economy and Law”

On March 19, the DonNTU’s Department of Management and Economic Law held the IV All-Russian Scientific and Practical Conference of Studying Youth “Topical Issues of Management, Economy and Law”. 
