The conference program covered 131 presentations made by 205 authors – academics, Master's students and postgraduates, researchers of South Federal University (Rostov-on-Don), Donetsk State University, Donskoi State Technical University (Rostov-on-Don), Siberian State University of Geosystems and Technologies (Novosibirsk), Management State University (Moscow), Taganrog Institute named after A. Chekhov, Donetsk Physical and Technical Institute named after A. Galkin, Mathematical Institute named after L. Sobolev (Novosibirsk), Psychology Institute of the RAS (Moscow). Students of secondary schools from Snezhnoye and Donetsk and Military Training Centre of South Federal University took place in the event too.

DonNTU's Students and Postgraduates are Team Advisors in the Frameworks of the Program "Sirius.Summer: Start your Project"

DonNTU hosted the final part of the program «Sirius. Summer: Start your Project» on May 16th. It was aimed at rising young people's interest in research and engineering. Teams of schoolchildren defended their works which they had been doing during a year. Companies from Moscow, Moscow oblast and Izhevsk were the project customers.

DonNTU's students and postgraduates were advisors of four different projects. The first was "Development of the Fantasy Style Computer Game". Three schoolchildren were in the big team of developers. They got the necessary competences to develop a single-user computer video game with a plot.

The second was the research project "Internet-sources: Ways to Search and Check Information". The main task was to check the skills of the students to analyze the Internet information, to form recommendations as to analyzing the Internet-sources. The project was aimed at widening the topical issue of modern education – developing the skills of information search and check in the Internet sources. It helps students to evaluate its reliability.

The main task was to create a home station to get meteorological signals from the satellites NOAA and “Meteor”.

The project teams’ participants and their advisors got souvenirs – T-shirts with the university logos and slogans developed by the Head of the Students’ Design Department Ms. Alexeeva. All works have development and commercializing prospects.
