Rector A. Ya. Anoprienko announced a significant event for DonNTU – the award of the Order of Engineering Glory by the Russian Academy of Engineering to the university for great services to the Russian and international scientific engineering community, the introduction of modern effective technologies into educational activities, the training of highly qualified scientific and engineering personnel, fruitful publishing activities and in connection with the 105th anniversary of the University.



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The meeting of the Academic council was attended by distinguished guests: Mikhail Nikolaevich Kushakov, Adviser to the Head of the DPR and First Minister of Education and Science of the Republic, Elena Nikolaevna Nikitina, Adviser to the Head of the DPR, former Minister of Information of the DPR and graduate of DonNTU, as well as Olga Leonidovna Leontovich, representative of Sberbank of Russia, partner of the university.

E. N. Nikitina conveyed congratulations from the Head of the DPR, D. V. Pushilin, and delivered personal congratulations to the university. M. N. Kushakov and O. L. Anoprienko, which included S. V. Ivanitsa, O. V. Kulkova and L. D. Kovalev. The decision to publish it was made in the centennial year of the university, and the book itself is of particular value. It describes in detail the difficult but heroic initial stages of the university's development, which is especially important in the current military conditions.

The XVII All-Russian Scientific and Technical Conference with International Participation "Informatics, Control Systems, Mathematical and Computer Modeling" (ICSMCM-26) is Held at DonNTU

On April 22-23rd, the 17th All-Russian Scientific and Technical Conference with International participation "Informatics, Control Systems, Mathematical and Computer Modeling" (ICSMCM-26) was held at the Scientific and Educational Institute of Computer Science and Technology of Donetsk National Technical University.

The purpose of the event is to exchange scientific and technical information, identify innovative prospects for informatization in all areas of modern society, develop joint scientific programs, develop cooperation, establish business contacts and commercial ties in the field of information technology.

The plenary session of the conference was held in a hybrid format on April 22nd. The participants were greeted by the rector of DonNTU, Alexander Yakovlevich Anoprienko. The work of the sections was held in face-to-face format on April 22-23rd. Bauman (Kaluga), Lipetsk State Technical University (Lipetsk), National Research University MIET (Moscow Moscow), Kosygin Russian State University (Moscow), Empress Catherine II Saint Petersburg Mining University (Saint Petersburg), Kuindzhi Mariupol State University (Mariupol), Platov South Russian State Polytechnic University (NPI) (Novocherkassk), Institute of Artificial Intelligence Problems (Donetsk).

The ICSMCM-26 conference became a platform for joint communication and partnership in the field of information technology, and its participants got acquainted with the latest technologies and trends in their chosen field.

Rector of DonNTU Participantes in the X Congress of the Union of Machine Engineers of Russia



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Sergey Chemezov, Chairman of the All-Russian Public Organization Union of Machine Builders of Russia (Soyuzmash), CEO of Rostec State Corporation, opened the Anniversary Congress of Machine Builders, which was hosted by the National Center “Russia” in Moscow on May 14th for the first time. The event, dedicated to summarizing the work of Russian machine builders over the very difficult five years since the last such meeting, was attended by President of the Russian Federation Vladimir Putin, Deputy Chairman of the Union of Machine Builders Vladimir Gutenev, representatives of federal authorities, heads of regional offices, major industry enterprises and leading

engineering universities.

For the first time, the regional branches of the DPR and LPR took part in the congress, the delegations of which included the heads of two leading engineering universities in Donbass – Donetsk National Technical University and Lugansk State University named after V. Dahl.

DonNTU Rector Alexander Anoprienko attended the congress both as one of two representatives of the Donetsk Regional Branch (together with Vladimir Alekhine, Head of the Office of the Donetsk Regional Council) and as one of two rectors of leading engineering universities in the new territories (together with Viktor Ryabichev, Rector of Luhansk State University named after V. Dahl). According to the rector of DonNTU, participation in the anniversary congress of representatives of the LDPR was an important event confirming the deepening integration of the industrial and educational potential of the Republics into the All-Russian system, as well as confirming the recognition of the modest, but already quite tangible contribution of Donbass and its technical universities to strengthening the country's technological independence and training qualified engineering personnel.

The main objectives of the congress were to summarize not only the past five-year plan, but also the entire 25-year work of SoyuzMash, as well as to develop an industry development strategy for 2026-2030.

Denis Manturov, First Deputy Prime Minister of the Russian Federation, addressed the participants with a welcoming speech. He also read out an address to the delegates by Mikhail Mishustin, Prime Minister of the Russian Federation.

The central point of the plenary session was Sergey Chemezov's report “On the activities of the Russian Engineering Union during the reporting period and tasks for the future”. He said: *“Today we face a key task – not just to keep the result, but to translate it into a sustainable model of long-term development. Industry must remain the foundation of our country's economic and technological leadership”*. Sergey Chemezov also emphasized the important role of the annual international forum

“Engineers of the Future” held under the auspices of SoyuzMash in working with young people (graduate students and engineering students of DonNTU have been actively participating in it for many years).

The congress culminated with a speech by Vladimir Putin, who first of all noted that it was pleasant to deal with people engaged in specific work. The President stressed that the current strategic line of the state was not to copy someone else’s, but to set trends in the markets, develop new types of competitive products, including the production of high-quality aircraft, railway, agricultural and other equipment, the creation and accelerated implementation of industrial robots, digital platforms and autonomous systems, artificial intelligence technologies. It was also emphasized that the Union of

Machine Builders, together with the Ministry of Education and Science, had built an end-to-end system for training engineering personnel. It covers all stages of professional development, including career guidance, talent identification, training, support and employment. This work must necessarily develop and continue, as it is focused on the future, on educating a generation with modern innovative engineering thinking, and it is these specialists who will have to solve the promising tasks of the country’s technological development. At the end of his speech, Vladimir Putin addressed the participants of the congress with the following words: *“I know what difficulties you have to go through. And I know that you are coping with it. You do it thanks to your organizational talent, commitment, and focus on the end result”*.

In general, the congress focused on the main key tasks aimed at developing the industry, including import substitution and technological sovereignty, reducing dependence on imported components in leading sectors, digitalization of production, the introduction of AI, robotics and big data to increase efficiency, as well as active partnership with engineering universities to overcome the acute shortage of personnel. due to the sharply increased need for highly qualified engineers and mid-level specialists.

Speakers included Valery Falkov, Minister of Higher Education and Science; Anton Alikhanov, Minister of

Industry and Trade; Alexey Likhachev, CEO of Rosatom; Alexander Pan, CEO of Radioelectronic Technologies (Kret); Peter Fradkov, Head of PSB Bank; and the Governor of the Rostov Region, which ranked first among regional companies, Yuri Slyusar and many others noted that, despite far from isolated problems (and some of them had significantly worsened in recent years), in general, there was an accelerated movement forward and in many areas the tasks of achieving not only technological sovereignty, but also technological leadership are being successfully solved.

Following the results of the voting, Sergey Chemezov was unanimously re-elected chairman of the Russian Engineering Union. The participants of the event emphasized its key role in strengthening the authority of the organization and developing systematic interaction with government authorities. According to the results of the congress, it was noted that the development of the industry was especially important for the national security and economic growth of the country. The delegates approved the updated Charter of the Union and a Resolution with 12 key recommendations for the Government.

Topical Issues of Intellectual Property are Discussed at the International Scientific Forum “Innovative Perspectives of Donbass”

The IV annual round table “Topical issues of intellectual property in ensuring innovative development – a regional aspect” was held on May 21st at the Youth House “30/09” in Donetsk. The event became part of the XII International Scientific Forum of the DPR “Innovative Perspectives of Donbass” and was timed to coincide with the Decade of Science and Technology in Russia.

Alexander Yakovlevich Anoprienko, Rector of Donetsk National Technical University and Head of the Donetsk Regional Organization VOIR (All-Russian Society of Innovators and Inventors), who is a member of the forum's presidium, addressed the participants with a welcoming speech. The rector stressed that inventions had always been a strong point of Donbass and Donetsk Polytechnic University. And now it is especially important to restore this tradition and actively engage in both patenting new developments and their commercialization.

Oleg Dyachenko, Executive Director of VOIR, presented a report on author's remuneration for service inventions. The topic turned out to be extremely relevant: the issue of balancing the interests of the employer and the inventor's author remains one of the most pressing practical problems. Oleg Dyachenko emphasized the need to introduce Regulations on Official Results of Intellectual Activity (RIA) and to pay remuneration for both the creation and commercialization of developments. He suggested setting fixed amounts tied to the average salary of an engineering or scientific worker; applying a progressive scale when using developments: the lower the royalties, the higher the share of the author.

The round table also discussed:

- the state policy of the Russian Federation in the field of intellectual property and regional practices;
- digital transformation and artificial intelligence;
- regional brands and creative industries;
- staffing in the field of intellectual property.

Representatives of Rospatent, FIIP, the Eurasian Patent Office and the Mordovia Technopark were among the special guests.

Representatives of DonNTU youth laboratories, graduate students, and young scientists actively participated in the round table.

Following the event, a resolution was adopted with specific proposals for the development of the intellectual property system in the Donetsk People's Republic.

The final meeting of the forum, which summed up its results, traditionally took place on May 28th in the Donetsk Botanical Garden. The event was attended by A. Ya. Anoprienko, Rector of DonNTU, S. V. Borshchevsky, Vice-rector, K. N. Labinsky, Head of the Department of Science and Innovation and his staff, M. P. Rudenko, Chairman of the Council of Young Scientists, teachers and young scientists of the university, and V. V. Kozub-Ptitsa Deputy Director of the Botanical Garden. Among the honored guests of the event were I. V. Kostenok, Deputy of the People's Council of the DPR, S. A. Zakharchenko, son of the first

Head of the DPR, as well as the Moscow delegation – O. F. Shakhov, Doctor of Economics, Director of the ANO "Research Center for Strategic Partnership of state and Business", and representatives of the ANO "Development of Bolshoy Serpukhov" headed by the director Y. S. Churakova, including V. E. Ananyev, Assistant to the President for the Biomedical Department of the Institute of Engineering Physics, I. A. Kudashov, Candidate of Technical Sciences, Candidate of Technical Sciences, Associate Professor, First Deputy Head of the Department of Biomedical Safety at MSTU, and others.

In his welcoming speech, the Rector of DonNTU congratulated everyone on the successful holding of the forum, which gathered more and more participants from all over Russia every year. The event gained a second life in 2014, which was the hardest year for our city. The massive shelling of Donetsk, the fierce battles for Ilovaysk and Debaltseve – many were confused and disheartened. Despite that, it was decided to resume the work of the Donbass 2020 forum (opened in 2000) under a new name. In May 2015, the First International Scientific Forum of the DPR "Innovative Perspectives of Donbass: infrastructural and socio-economic development" was held on a big rise with the participation of representatives of leading universities in Russia and the LPR. Since then, the forum has been held annually, despite any difficulties, sometimes in a remote format. A. Ya. Anoprienko recalled that 2026 was a special year for DonNTU: on May 30th, the university celebrated its 105th anniversary, and in October it would mark 100 years since its transformation from a mining college to a mining institute. Rapidly developing, the institute played an urban-forming role, launching the transformation of the factory village of Yuzovka into a modern metropolis with all urban attributes: water supply, sewerage, gas, urban garden, electricity and electric transport - all this was implemented on the initiative and by the efforts of DMI teachers and students. It is symbolic that the current forum is taking place during the development of the Republic's development program until 2042, which DonNTU will also participate in.

V. V. Kozub-Ptitsa, Deputy Director of the DBG, made a presentation on "Promising areas of breeding work at the Donetsk Botanical Garden". She noted the uniqueness of the garden, in which everything was created exclusively in steppe conditions, told about its history, areas of work, results achieved, and plans for the future.

I. V. Kostenok, Deputy of the People's Council of the DPR, expressed confidence that Donbass would definitely be a winner in everything, as people who did not leave it in the most difficult times perform small feats in their workplaces every day in the name of its revival and prosperity. He presented souvenir bells with the inscription "Donetsk 2026. We're writing history together" to the representatives of DonNTU, the Botanical Garden and the Moscow delegation.

Memorable gifts were also exchanged between Donetsk polytechnics and employees of the Institute of Engineering Physics, who have growing partnerships.

K. N. Labinsky, Head of the Department of Science and Innovation at DonNTU, concluded the official part of the event by summarizing the results of the forum. He stressed that two events traditionally

The event is organized by the National Research University Higher School of Economics (HSE) in conjunction with the presidential platform “Russia is a Land of Opportunity” and the Rosmolodezh program “More than a Journey” with the support of the Russian Geographical Society and the Mashuk Knowledge Center.

77 people from 26 regions of Russia came to the meeting. Among them were mentors and organizers of past expeditions, university professors, representatives of non-profit organizations, as well as students with expedition experience and interested in their development as mentors.

Elena Vladimirovna Alekseeva, Head of the DonNTU Student Design Department, who was the only representative of the new regions at that meeting, took an active part in the event. E. V. Alekseeva also became one of the three winners of the short story contest “Once upon an Expedition”, which was held as part of the event. Her fascinating story about one of her travels with students in Russia aroused lively emotions and interest among the audience.

Lectures and master classes were held as part of the program. The participants analyzed the methods of sociological research of territories, learned how to work with the motivation of teams, collect feedback and present the results of expeditions, for example, in the format of books, videos and exhibitions. The panel session discussed how to build a long-term partnership with the municipal authorities and turn the expedition into a driver for the development of small towns and settlements.

The acquired knowledge and team activities will serve as an impetus for the preparation of bright expeditions in 2026. Students and postgraduates of Donetsk Polytechnic University will be able to take part in some of them. Registration for the selection of projects is open on the website.

Representatives of DonNTU are Participants of the International Conference on Industrial Explosives

On May 11-14th, the International Scientific and Technical Conference “Industrial Explosives: state, prospects of development and application” was held in Dzerzhinsk on the basis of the Rancho 636 Country Club, dedicated to the 25th anniversary of the creation of the first modular installation for the production of emulsion explosives in Russia. The organizer of the event is JSC state research institute Kristall.

The conference reviewed the results of theoretical and experimental research on the development and testing of industrial explosives (IE) for extractive industries, construction, and other purposes. Issues of safety in the manufacture, transportation and use of IE, experience in the development and operation of equipment, installations and mixing and charging equipment for the manufacture of IE in the field of application, and other aspects were also discussed. In addition, the conference program included a sightseeing tour of the city of Dzerzhinsk, a visit to the Shukhov Tower, and other cultural events.

At the invitation of the organizers, representatives of DonNTU took part in the conference: S. V. Borshchevsky, Vice-rector for Scientific Work, S. A. Kalyakin, Professor, I. V. Kupenko, Associate Professor, and N. D. Barsuk, assistant (Department of Construction of Buildings, Underground Structures and Geomechanics). Donetsk Polytechnics prepared two reports. The topic of the first presentation was the justification of the effectiveness of the inhibitor for safety charges of emulsion explosives and explosion protection equipment for mining coal mines. In the introductory part, S. V. Borshchevsky briefly spoke about the prospects for the development of DonNTU, thanked the organizers and sponsors of the conference and invited those present to cooperate with Donetsk Polytechnic University. In the second report, “Development and improvement of explosive safety charges”, a promising design of an explosive safety charge in the form of interconnected cartridges in a polyvinyl chloride shell was considered.

On the final day of the event, Donetsk residents presented the conference participants with copies of the recently published monograph “Infrared radiation of explosive products of energy-saturated substances and mixtures”, prepared based on the results of the DonNTU search (oriented fundamental) Research project “To investigate and develop a method for determining the safety properties of explosives from the radiation spectrum of an excited methane-air mixture” (FRRF-2023-0002). Representatives of DonNTU noted the genuine interest in their developments, the warm welcome from the organizers and participants of the conference, their willingness to cooperate, as well as the high level of organization of the event.

On May 12-15th, Kolomna hosted a major scientific event – the XIII International Scientific and Practical Conference “Integrated Models and Soft Computing in Artificial Intelligence”, which was attended by representatives of the Department of Software Engineering named after L. P. Feldman: Alexander Vladimirovich Grigoriev, Associate Professor, Irina Aleksandrovna Kolomoitseva, Senior lecturer, and Nikolay Vladimirovich Meleshchenko, graduate student. The event is organized by the Russian Association of Artificial Intelligence (RAAI).

The conference was held in 6 sections and covered the following modern areas of artificial intelligence (AI): knowledge engineering; data mining; reasoning modeling; text mining, large language models; fuzzy models, soft measurements and calculations, bioinspired methods; intelligent agents, robots, computer vision; intelligent management and decision support; machine learning, neural network methods, neuroinformatics; tools and technologies for designing intelligent systems; applied intelligent systems.

The event was attended by more than 120 scientists, researchers and specialists from Russia and Belarus. After reviewing, the program committee selected 63 reports, from which the conference program was compiled. There were scheduled plenary sessions and a round table. Leading scientists in the field of artificial intelligence made overview presentations at the plenary sessions. The following issues were considered: “Development of artificial intelligence technologies in 2025-26. Using artificial intelligence for scientific research and development” (speaker – Yu. V. Visilter, Doctor of Physical and Mathematical Sciences, Professor), “Cognitive interface for decision support systems in a fuzzy world” (speaker – B. A. Kobrinsky, Doctor of Medical Sciences, Professor), “Intelligent systems – is it an intuitive idea or an operationally definable concept?” (speaker – M.I. Zabezhailo, Doctor of Physical and Mathematical Sciences, Senior researcher). Three reports were presented from DonNTU. At the section on fuzzy models and soft computing, Alexander Vladimirovich Grigoriev presented his joint report with graduate student Dmitry Chernyshov on the topic “Analysis of modeling problems in CAD in the presence of NON-factors in the initial data and calculations”. The section “Data Mining, Knowledge Engineering and Ontology” featured two reports led by Oleg Ivanovich Fedyaev, Associate Professor of the Department of Software Engineering named after L.P. Feldman. Irina Aleksandrovna Kolomoitseva made a presentation on “Integration of the subject thesaurus into a two-stage information search model: the architecture of the CodeLex system”, and Nikolai Vladimirovich Meleshchenko presented the work “Formalization of knowledge in the task of updating work programs of disciplines”. The results of all three reports were obtained according to the work plan of the Youth Scientific Laboratory “Artificial Intelligence” of the university.

Within the framework of the conference, a congress of the Association of Fuzzy Systems and Soft Computing was held, which was attended by representatives of DonNTU.

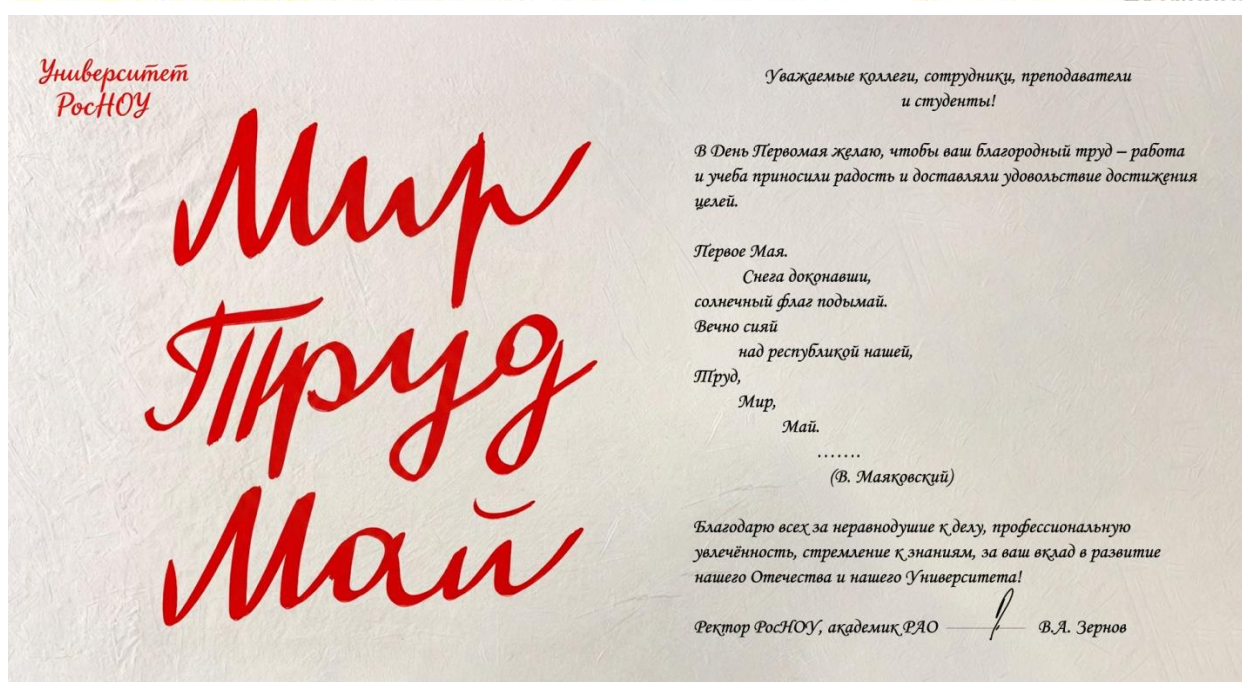

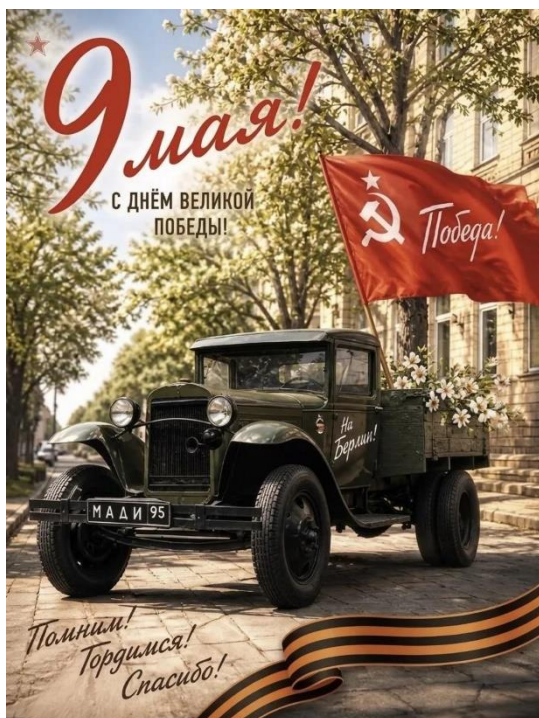
