



Ural State Mining University Gives a Collection of Minerals to DonNTU as Part of the Signing of a Cooperation Agreement

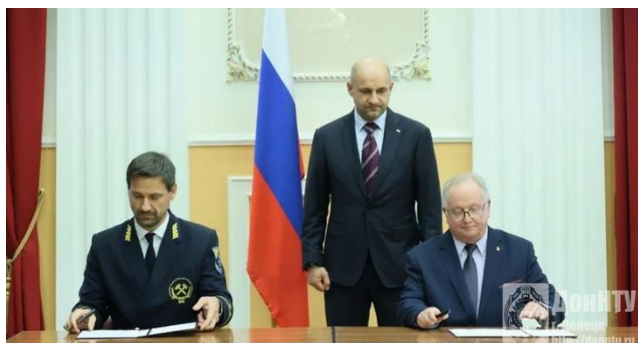

Alexander Yakovlevich Anoprienko, the Rector of Donetsk National Technical University, Andrey Nikolaevich Ryazanov, the Vice-rector, and Irina Viktorovna Filatova, the Dean of the Faculty of Subsoil Use and Earth Sciences, visited Ural State Mining University (USMU). On November 6th, a collection of 1,300 samples of minerals, rocks and ores was handed over to Donetsk polytechnics for practical classes on the basics of mineralogy, petrography and general geology. There was also a ceremony of signing a cooperation agreement between DonNTU and USMU, which were part of the consortium “Nedra”, which

united universities that trained specialists for the mineral resource complex of the Russian Federation.

The event was attended by Artyom Vladimirovich Zhoga, the Plenipotentiary Representative of the President of Russia in the Ural Federal District. “Ural and Donbass are bound by a strong, indestructible friendship, and today it will become even stronger. The agreement between Ural State Mining and Donetsk National Technical Universities will connect the two schools of mining, marking the beginning of a real mining fraternity. It is especially important that cooperation between higher education institutions begins with concrete cases. Ural State Mining University is transferring a collection of minerals, rocks and ores to colleagues from Donetsk” the envoy underlined.

At the event, Alexander Yakovlevich Anoprienko, the Rector of DonNTU, said that the university's mineral collection had suffered greatly during the shelling and efforts would be directed towards its restoration. Fruitful cooperation between the two universities will help to make a significant contribution to the common victory, which will lead to technological leadership.

Gleb Igorevich Batrak, the Rector of USMU, emphasized that the country was going through difficult times and it was necessary to unite, focus on tasks, support each other and move towards victory together.

He also noted that the signing of the agreement would help improve the skills of engineers in Ural and Donbass.

The Rector of DonNTU is a Participant in the Seminar of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation on the Formation of a Socio-Humanitarian Core in the Framework of Higher Education Reform

On October 24th, Valery Nikolaevich Falkov, the Minister of Science and Higher Education of Russia, opened a discussion at a conference in Sevastopol on the content of the socio-humanitarian core of disciplines as part of the transition to a new model of higher education. Welcoming the participants of the event, he noted the importance of the venue for the discussion on such a key issue – the “New Chersonesos”. It is a museum and temple complex in Sevastopol, which is increasingly called the “Homeland of our Homeland”. “Russia is a rich country in every sense. First of all, in a spiritual, meaningful way. There are many places for meeting. But taking into account what has appeared here in Sevastopol, in Crimea, and keeping in mind the attention you pay to education and upbringing, it is hardly possible to find a better place to discuss issues of the socio-humanitarian core,” the minister noted. He emphasized that at the meeting, along with rectors of various universities from all regions of Russia – classical, technical and many other industry – they invited “iconic, outstanding people of our time, those who form meanings and lead in terms of content, who are read, with whom people agree, argue and who they support.”

The participation of key figures shaping the modern intellectual and spiritual field of the country in the discussions of the seminar determined the special significance of the dialogue that took place. The presence of such thinkers as Alexander Dugin and the deep, penetrating words of Metropolitan Tikhon of Simferopol and Crimea set a high level of understanding of the challenges facing higher education. Metropolitan Tikhon noted the special need to “find bridges between youth and our generation,” and it was the dialogue of epochs, values and meanings that actually took place in Sevastopol.

The discussion was also attended by Konstantin Ilyich Mogilevsky and Olga Viktorovna Petrova, the Deputy Ministers of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation, Mikhail Vladimirovich Razvozhaev, the Governor of Sevastopol, and his deputy Igor Anatolyevich Mikheev, who oversee the implementation of a unified state policy in the field of education and science, rectors of leading universities of the Russian Federation: Sevastopol State University – Vladimir Dmitrievich Nechaev, Southern Federal University – Inna Konstantinovna Shevchenko, Tomsk State University – Eduard Vladimirovich Galazhinsky, Pyatigorsk State University – Alexander Pavlovich Gorbunov, Donetsk National Technical University – Alexander Yakovlevich Anoprienko and many others, among whom were the authors of textbooks and landmark monographs of socio-humanitarian content.

Following the discussion, Valery Nikolaevich Falkov noted that the new model of the socio-humanitarian core of higher education would be based on three fundamental principles:

1. Ensuring fundamentality as the basis of higher education, suggesting that we should provide not just a set of competencies, but a holistic world view, a system of knowledge and values that will become a solid foundation for professional and personal growth throughout life.

2. Creation of a coherent and unified educational space for the whole country. This will ensure genuine in-Russian mobility of students, strengthening the unity of the nation and opening up new opportunities for academic exchange.

3. Consistent reduction of the paper work on teachers. It is important to free up teachers' time for their main mission – education and upbringing, scientific work and creative search.

The participants were confident that the synthesis of strong engineering education with deep social and humanitarian training was the formula for the success of our graduates in the modern world, and the new model of higher education would not only provide relevant knowledge, but also educated active and motivated citizens who were ready to create the future of Russia, leading both in technological development and in the humanitarian field.

The main results of the seminar and related tasks were discussed at a meeting of the DonNTU Academic Council on October 31st.

On October 30th Donetsk National Technical University hosted the III All-Russian Scientific and Technological Dictation, which took place within the framework of the “Technoprom” International Forum for Technological Development. The organizer was the Foundation for Scientific and Technological Development of the Novosibirsk Region and the Ministry of Science and Innovation Policy of the Novosibirsk Region. This year the organization and holding of the event has carried out jointly with the federal United Russia party project “Choose your own”.

The theme of this year's dictation was “Victory Technologies”. The participants got acquainted with the technologies and scientific discoveries that contributed to achieving success at the front and in the rear during the Great Patriotic War in various fields.

The event was opened by Yulia Mikhailovna Kryukova, the Deputy of the People's Council of the DPR, the Chairperson of the public council of the United Russia party project “Choose Your Own” in the Republic. She noted that the Donetsk People's Republic was taking part in that event for the first time. The dictation supports the desire of schoolchildren, students, young scientists and specialists to benefit the country in scientific and technological development. Donetsk Polytechnics are Participants of the Scientific and Practical Conference “The Unity of Nations that Won the Great War of 1941-1945 and Obliges to Win Today” in Nalchik

On October 24-27th, Kabardino-Balkarian State University named after H.M. Berbekov (Nalchik) and its Elbrus Educational and Scientific Complex hosted a scientific and practical conference “The Unity of peoples that won the Great War of 1941-1945 and obliges to win today”, dedicated to the 80th anniversary of Victory in the Great Patriotic War. The co-organizer is the Commission of the Russian Academy of Sciences for the Study of the Scientific heritage of outstanding Scientists.

The event has become a landmark socio-political event. The work was attended by

scientists, teachers and students of universities from different regions of Russia, as well as representatives of Abkhazia, Belarus and Serbia.

The speeches of Academician of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Hero of Socialist Labor M.C. Zalikhanov and an outstanding Russian politician and statesman, Professor S.N. Baburin, were vivid and memorable. They clearly analyzed the aggressive initiatives of the collective West, identified measures to counter destructive challenges and priorities for the development of the social forces of the Russian world.

Donetsk polytechnics also contributed to the work of the conference. Historical facts related to the fighting in the North Caucasus (the Great Patriotic War, counter-terrorism measures at the beginning of the XXI century) were revealed in a speech by the Vice-rector of DonNTU A.E. Fedorov, and Professor K.N. Marenich made a presentation “The Ukrainian challenge as the first phase of the revenge of the collective West”.

Within the framework of the event, arguments were developed against the unscientific claims of Western propagandists and politicians about the denial of the phenomenon of the historical unity of the Soviet peoples in the fight against Hitler's Germany and the defeat of militaristic Japan in World War II and, in general, about the decisive role of the USSR and the Red Army in achieving the Great Victory.

The analysis of historical events confirms the civilizational essence of the global confrontation between Russia and the West, which, in particular, is expressed in the distortion and falsification of the true history of the Second World War, the indoctrination of the peoples of the former USSR to impose on them feelings of guilt for the "unleashing" of military confrontation and the so-called occupation of European countries, and is an integral part of the Western ideology of Russophobia and rejection Russian world and the Russian civilization.

The conference was aimed at developing a system of scientific argumentation against the aggressive challenges of the collective West, as well as improving the historical education of young people, including in terms of understanding the origins and causes of events related to Ukraine at that time.

The Staff of the Department of Software Engineering named after L. P. Feldman are Active Participants in All-Russian Scientific Conferences on Artificial Intelligence

On October 20-25th, Taganrog hosted the XIII All-Russian Scientific Conference "System Synthesis and Applied Synergetics" on the base of the Institute of Computer Technology and Information Security of the Southern Federal University. The following modern areas were considered at the conference: problems of self-organization and management in complex technical systems; artificial intelligence in management: theory and practice; unmanned automated systems; modern educational technologies in the field of engineering personnel training. At the section "Fuzzy systems, soft computing and intelligent information processing", the Associate Professor Oleg Ivanovich Fedyaev made a presentation "Synthesis of a multi-agent simulation model of the training process at the university department level", which considered the solution to the problem of analyzing distributed interaction processes in the "department-students-enterprises" triad using intelligent agents.

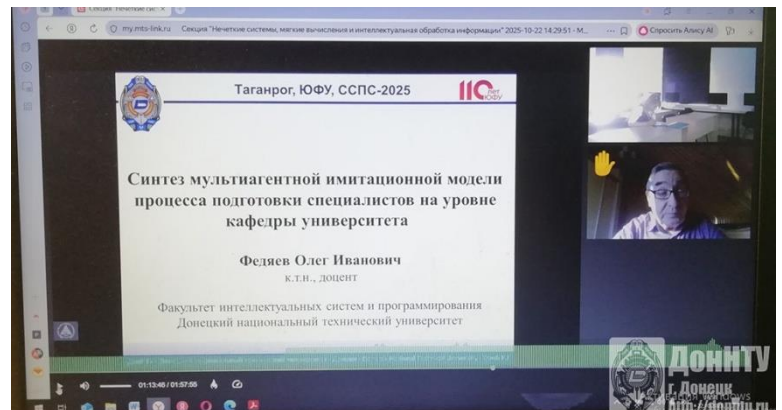

On October 9-10th, Perm State National Research University hosted the X All-Russian Scientific and Practical Conference with international participation "Artificial Intelligence in solving urgent social and economic problems of the XXI century". The event is dedicated to discussing the development and application of artificial intelligence methods for solving knowledge extraction, pattern recognition, optimization, forecasting, and management of objects, processes, and phenomena.

There were remote presentations of graduate students of the Department of Software Engineering named after L.P. Feldman – Anton Sukhanov ("Studies of the dependence of recognition accuracy on the speed of a person passing in front of a video camera") and Alexander Murashchenko ("Tracking the dynamics of students' movement in the classroom using the YOLO neural network") at the conference, which considered the digitalization of classroom monitoring computer vision methods (project leader – Associate Professor O.I. Fedyaev).

In Kemerovo, postgraduate and undergraduates of the Department of Software Engineering named after L.P. Feldman (scientific supervisor – Associate Professor O.I. Fedyaev) took part in the All-Russian Scientific and Practical Conference "Information and Telecommunication Systems and Technologies" (ITS&T-2025), which was held at the Kuzbass State Technical University named after T.F. Gorbachev on October 22-24th. At the section "Information systems and technologies in science and education", they made remote presentations: "A study of the influence of the size of datasets and the dynamics of face transmission

in a video stream on recognition accuracy” (graduate student, junior researcher at the DonNTU Youth laboratory “Artificial Intelligence” A. Sukhanov), “Development of the architecture of an intelligent email assistant for advising students on the discipline” (master's student N. Zozulya), “The use of reinforcement learning methods to develop an optimal strategy for the teacher's activities according to his key indicators” (Master's student D. Kiselyov).

All reports are included in the collections of relevant conferences and will be posted in the RISC database.

Activists of the YC RGS “Donbass” are Participants in a Video Conference with the YC RGS of the Smolensk Region

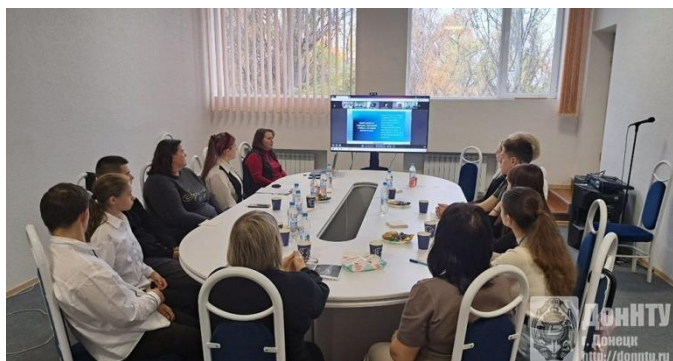

On October 27th, activists of the Youth Club of the Russian Geographical Society “Donbass” participated in a videoconference with the Youth Center of the Russian Geographical Society of the Smolensk region. The online meeting was attended by the Youth Center of the RGS of the DPR and eight of its youth clubs, including “Compass of Donbass”, “Conquerors of Peaks”, “Meridian”, “VectorDon”, “37 Meridian”, which recently opened in the territory of the Donetsk People's Republic.

“YC RGS “Donbass” was one of the first to be opened on the territory of the DPR and had been operating on the basis of DonNTU since September 2022,” said Anna Yurievna Efimova, the event's host, head of the Youth Center of the RGS of the DPR. On behalf of DonNTU, the event was attended by Alina Vitalievna Tonofa, the Head of the YC RGS “Donbass”, and Andrey Dolik, a third-year student at the Faculty of Subsoil Use and Earth Sciences, YC activist, participant in international geological festivals, who introduced the geological features of Donbass, illustrating the story with a presentation prepared jointly with Yulia Anatolyevna Proskurnya, the Associate Professor of the Department of Geology and Exploration of Mineral Deposits. We are separated by kilometers, but we are united by a common history and the indomitable will of the people,” said Egor Denisovich Kozher, the Head of the Youth Center of the Russian Geographical Society of the Smolensk Region.

The teleconference marked the beginning of a long journey for future joint research and projects that would strengthen ties between youth clubs in Russia's regions.

The purpose of the event is the exchange of experience between educational institutions, students and teachers of the Republic of Dagestan

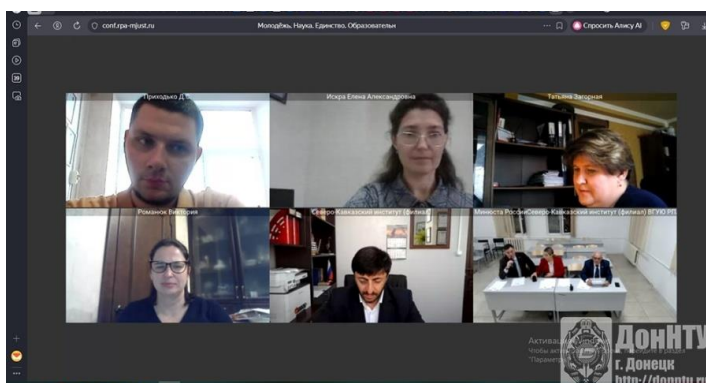

Shaforostova “Promising directions of an integrated approach in the field of waste management in the mining industry in the conditions of the DPR” focuses on the need to introduce innovative technologies and methods of waste processing to minimize the negative impact of the mining industry on the environment.

Y. Y. Aslamova presented the work “Integrated utilization of iron and lime-containing ferrous metallurgy waste as a factor of environmental, economic and social sustainability of metallurgical regions”. She noted the importance of developing integrated solutions for the recycling of metallurgical waste, which

would not only reduce the burden on the environment, but also benefit economically from the recycling of resources.

The reports of the DonNTU scientists aroused great interest among the conference participants and became the reason for a fruitful discussion.

Donetsk Polytechnics has also established contacts with the scientific ecological community of the Volga Federal District, Moscow, St. Petersburg, Rostov-on-Don, which opens up new prospects for cooperation and joint scientific projects in the field of environmental protection.

Participation in the event was an important step in the integration of DonNTU into the Russian scientific space and confirmed the high level of scientific research conducted at the university.

**DonNTU Hosted a Scientific and Practical Conference
“Artistic Metal through the Prism of Centuries”
Dedicated to the 130th Anniversary of Mertsalov’s Palm**

On November 14th, the scientific and practical conference “Artistic Metal through the prism of centuries” was held at Donetsk National Technical University. The “Art-Donbass” Museum initiated and organized the event, and DonNTU, the oldest engineering university in the region, offered technical opportunities for the event, and became its co-organizer. The conference is dedicated to the 130th anniversary of the masterpiece of blacksmithing – the Mertsalov’s Palm, which was forged in three weeks by Alexey Ivanovich Mertsalov and his assistant Philip Fedorovich Shkarin from a single rail using only a hammer and chisel.

The event was attended by Vice-rectors of DonNTU Alexey Borisovich Biryukov, Andrey Nikolaevich Ryazanov and Sergey Vasilyevich Borshchevsky, Deans of faculties, Director of the Museum of the History of the university Lidiya Dmitrievna Kovaleva, teachers, students and staff of DonNTU, as well as representatives of the Donetsk Republican Museum of Local Lore, Belgorod State Technological University named after V. G. Shukhov, the Museum of Donetsk Metallurgical Plant and the Guild Kuznetsov of Donbass.

The conference was opened by Alexey Borisovich Biryukov. He noted that the Mertsalov’s Palm, the business card of Donbass, is a unique object both from a technical and an artistic point of view. It is impossible to create something like this without using modern technologies and equipment, but 130 years ago Donetsk blacksmiths forged this work of art. The Palm is located in the museum of St. Petersburg Mining University of Empress Catherine II, and there a 2-fold smaller copy of it in the hall of DonNTU, which causes great pride of all polytechnics. This facility holds many secrets, and at the event, the speakers will

reveal its secrets. The Vice-Rector noted that the conference covered the aesthetic aspects of blacksmithing, as well as practical issues of the industry. Alexey Borisovich is sure that such events will attract the attention of students and teachers, because they combine technology and art, and a real engineer-inventor must think in a diverse way.

Viktor Ivanovich Burduk, the Chairman of the Guild of Blacksmiths of Donbass, a graduate of DonNTU, spoke about the important goal of the conference – to close the “blank spots” in history of the Mertsalov’s Palm with truthful facts about this unique object. History and the mythologies associated with it continue to be the subject of discussion and debate among local historians, journalists, blacksmiths and all those who are not indifferent to the culture and art of Donbass.

The conference also included a presentation of a book by Donetsk authors – Evgeny Yurievich Lavrinenko, the Secretary of the Donbass Blacksmith Guild, an employee of the “Art-Donbass” Museum, Vladimir Alekseevich Martynenko, a leading engineer at the Special Design Bureau of Radio Engineering Devices, and Vladimir Anatolyevich Sidorov, the Professor of the Department of Mechanical Equipment of Ferrous Metallurgy Plants named after V. Y. Sedush at DonNTU. The book is called “Palms of the Donetsk Steppes”. The publication has been published in October of this year and is the first to collect all the known facts about the outstanding artistic forging product and its replicas. DonNTU Professor Vladimir Anatolyevich Sidorov noted that the idea of writing the book arose after the blacksmithing festivals in the region. He said that the main author of the publication, Vladimir Alekseevich Martynenko, had already prepared a second book, which included all currently known information about the Palm, but the steel grade, weight and size parameters and manufacturing technology of the Palm stayed mysteries.

The following topics were also discussed at the conference:

- “Outstanding Russian artistic metal products of the XIX century”;
- “Outstanding artistic metal products of the XX century”;
- “Artistic metal of the XXI century – bright projects”.

Following the results of the event, it was decided to recommend local historians to fill in the lack of information about Konstantin Yakovlevich Zakharenkov, a graduate of the Mining Institute, an engineer at the Stalin Plant, who had solved the mystery of the Yuzovskaya Palm and had said about its authors, as well as to develop a method for contactless determination of mass and dimensional parameters to create an exact copy of that unique product.

At the end of the event, the Guild of Blacksmiths of Donbass presented thanks to the participants of the conference, including Donetsk polytechnics, for their contribution to the preservation of blacksmithing traditions and the development of decorative and applied arts of Donbass.

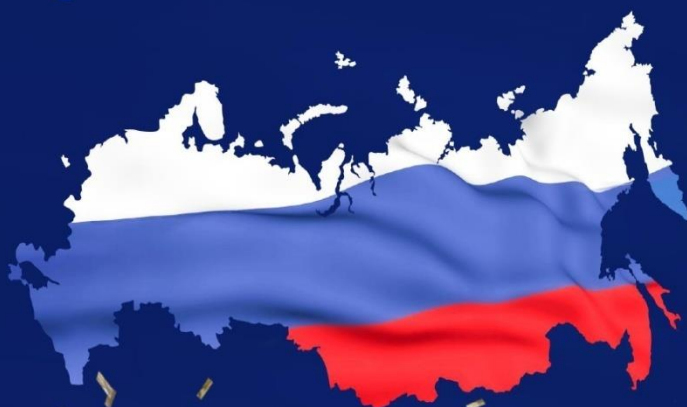
